AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. When traveling with your dogs, you should always have copies of their rabies vaccination certificates.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors on a grass surface. There will be one ring. The ring size will be 120ft x 120ft completely surrounded by chain link fencing.

JUNIOR HANDLER DISCOUNTS: RGDOC offers ½ price entry fees for handlers under the age of 18. An AKC Junior Handler number must be included on the Entry Form. To obtain a free Junior Handler number, call the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Handler substitutions can be made before entries close by paying additional entry fees. No handler substitutions allowed after the closing date/time. Refunds will not be given if the assigned Junior is unavailable to handle the dog.

Mail entry forms and fees to Kim Fuqua, Trial Secretary, 95 E Afton Road, La Mesa, NM 88044. Please make checks payable to **RGDOC**. No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. No online entries will be accepted. No hand delivered entries will be accepted within the first 24 hours after opening. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Kim Fuqua at aussiesandbcs@gmail.com. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance..

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund 100% per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. In order to receive a refund, the handler must notify the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. **Dogs that are injured** after closing will be refunded up to 75% of their entry fees provided that the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials and a signed note from a veterinarian is provided.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

*Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.*

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Please read carefully! Exhibitors are responsible for understanding and following these rules and entering correctly.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out.

In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) (FEO runs will NOT be offered at these trials!)

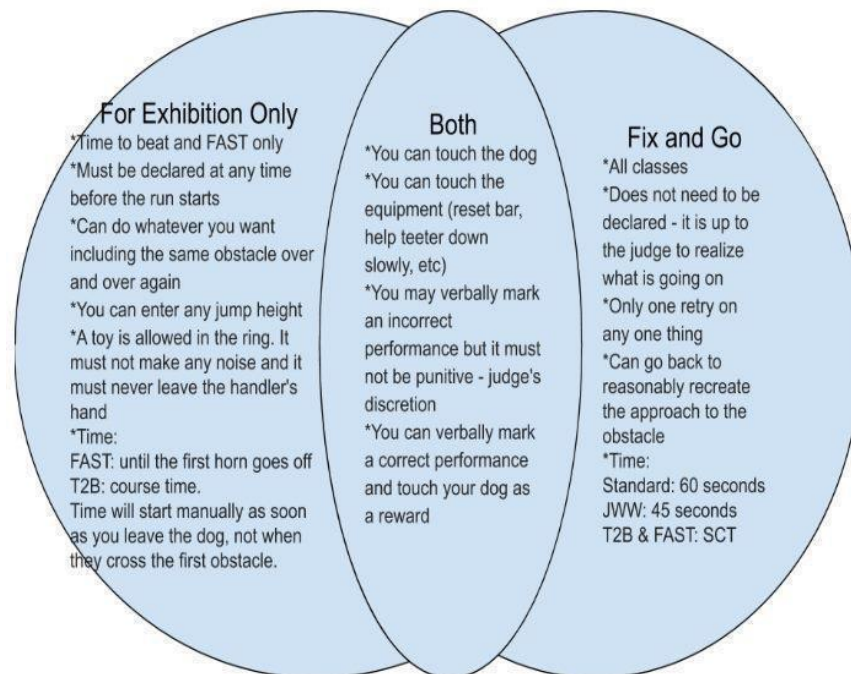
For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

MAP FOR PARKING AND CRATING WILL BE SENT WITH THE FINAL CONFIRMATION.

RV Parking: There will be very limited RV parking on site. Those spaces are reserved for key trial workers. Please Contact: Kim Fuqua, Trial Secretary at aussiesandbcs@gmail.com for reservations. Please include #nights you will be staying, size of your RV and if you want electric. Additional RV information below.

Crating space: Exhibitors are encouraged to crate out of their cars if at all possible. There is some room not designated for parking where you can crate under trees or set up a canopy for shade. Crates may be left overnight; however, the RGDOC and Don and Kim Fuqua will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas.

Vendors: There will not be any food vendors on site. Restaurants and Fast food are 15-30 minutes away, so please plan accordingly, or you may bring your own food and drink to consume in your car. Water will be available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to comply may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

No dogs are allowed unattended at the site overnight.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

All handlers will be assigned a walk-run group for each class in which they are entered. Handlers will be allowed 8 minutes to walk the course without a dog. Each walk-through will be limited to handlers entered in that class and that particular walk-run group only. A warmup jump will be available for use prior to your run.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for viewing at the trial secretary booth. None will be sold. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge and posted online after closing.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place..... Blue
Second Place..... Red
Third Place..... Yellow
Fourth Place..... White
Qualifying Score..... Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be available to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. Double Q medallions are available to any dog earning qualifying scores in both Master Standard and JWW. MACH/PACH ribbons and decorated bars will be offered.

AWARDS MAY BE CLAIMED THE FOLLOWING DAY OF THE TRIAL, OR CAN BE MAILED IF THE EXHIBITOR LEAVES A SASE.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Rio Grande Dog Obedience Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **Rio Grande**

Dog Obedience Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Rio Grande Dog Obedience Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. **The entire Las Cruces Dog Sports property is considered the trial grounds. Please be aware there is livestock on the grounds. Please do not allow your dog to harass or interact with sheep, chickens, or goats.**

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Trial Committee will be strictly enforced, including, but not limited to, the recorded information in this premium list.

SPECIAL COVID CONSIDERATIONS

- **All New Mexico State COVID public health orders that are in effect on the trial dates will be enforced, including any mandatory quarantine requirements for people entering from outside of NM or who have traveled outside of NM.** Refer to the NM Department of Health's website at <https://cv.nmhealth.org/> for more information.
- **AKC's Suggested Best Practices** for agility trials will be followed as current conditions dictate.
- **MASKS MUST BE WORN PROPERLY AT ALL TIMES AT THE TRIAL SITE PER THE CURRENT PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER!** We will announce whether exhibitors will be required to run with masks on during the trial as we get closer to the trial date. This will be in the general briefing letter so be prepared either way.
- **Exhibitors will do a simple COVID screen & sign a COVID waiver prior to their walk-through.**
- **No spectators/guests** will be allowed at these trials. No exceptions!
- **In the event that these trials are cancelled** due to changing COVID conditions, exhibitors will receive a full refund of their entry fees.
- **Exhibitors who develop COVID symptoms** and/or have an exposure/positive test after the closing date should withdraw and will receive a full refund of their entry fees for any unused runs.
- **Failure to comply** with any of these measures may result in a committee hearing, and/or immediate ejection from the trial, with no refund of fees.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From I-10 (from Las Cruces or El Paso) take Vado Exit 155 for NM 277 towards Berino/Vado heading west. At the roundabout on the west side of I-10 take the second exit (west) onto NM 277 for 1.5 miles. At the stop sign, turn left onto NM 478 (south) for 700ft. Then turn right onto NM 189 (west) for 1.5 miles (you will cross the railroad tracks and the Rio Grande). At the stop sign, you will turn left onto NM 28 (south) for 2 miles. You will then turn left onto Afton road and the destination is 200ft on your left. 95 E Afton Rd, La Mesa, NM 88044. (You will also see the Agility trial signs on the turn from NM 28 and Afton Road).
