MASS THEME

BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

**Theme: Sharing Life with Christ**  
In an affluent society basic food such as bread and water is no problem. However, for many people in the world it still is. Thus they can understand better than we do that it is a real sign of love and care when God intervenes to feed his people. For them, water and bread are a question of life and death. But we are often hungry and thirsty for other values than sustenance of physical life. In a depersonalized society we suffer from absence where there should be presence. We hunger and thirst for companionship, love, concern, mercy, respect, which are no problems in the great family of primitive people. Whose need is greater? Where we suffer from absence, the Lord Jesus wants to be present to us with all the concern and love of a friend for a friend. In the signs of plain daily food for Orientals, water, bread, wine, Jesus indicates what he intends by being present to us. He wants to share life. He wants to strengthen. He wants to mean something to you and me. When we celebrate the Eucharist, we celebrate this mysterious presence of the Lord Jesus with the community. Open up to make "Communion" possible. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord" (Communion Antiphon).

**FIRST READING Gn 14:18-20**  
**[Blessing of Melchizedek]**

It is not clear why Melchizedek is called "a priest of God Most High." The Letter to the Hebrews (Ch. 7) refers to this passage and sees Melchizedek as a priest, foreshadowing Jesus Christ, because he blessed Abraham. Church tradition, as reflected in the first Eucharistic Pray-

er, refers to the bread and wine offered by this mysterious King Priest. It may be that Melchizedek had offered the gifts of bread and wine previously to God and gave them to Abraham as a sacrificial repast together with his blessing. As such they could be types of the Eucharistic bread and wine, the Body and Blood of our Lord "Be pleased to look upon these offerings... and to accept them, as once you were pleased to accept the gifts of your servant Abel the just, the sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith, and the offering of your high priest Melchizedek" (Eucharistic Prayer I). Relate the Responsorial Psalm to our High Priest, Jesus Christ!

**SECOND READING 1 Cor 11:23-26**  
**[The First Eucharist]**

The early Church celebrated the Eucharist as part of a communal meal, the "agape." Even today parish activities, picnics, and potluck dinners keep the members together and impart that feeling of belonging which we all need to persevere in the Christian way of life. However, in Corinth it had gotten out of hand. The rich brought their own food and did not share it with those who had less or nothing. Hence, the meal, which should result in a closer oneness of Christians, became a means of division. Referring to this abuse, Paul invites the Christians of Corinth to meditate on the real meaning of the Eucharist. Are you aware that your partaking in the Eucharistic Banquet signifies not only your oneness with the Host, Jesus Christ, but also your oneness with the guests at that banquet, your fellow parishioners?
