 history.
- If your Unit/District is planning any activities when our National President visits, include those activities in your history.
- Document any special events in your Unit/District and how they relate to both Department and National theme.
- Did your unit get media coverage from newspapers or local television?
- If submitting a History Book at Convention, read, read and read the instructions. Go to the Department website and look at the book of awards. All instructions are listed there.
