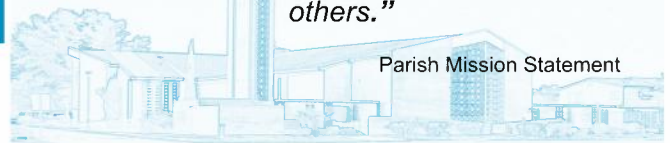

A conservative estimate is that donated ultrasounds will save the lives of at least 100,000 unborn children this year.
