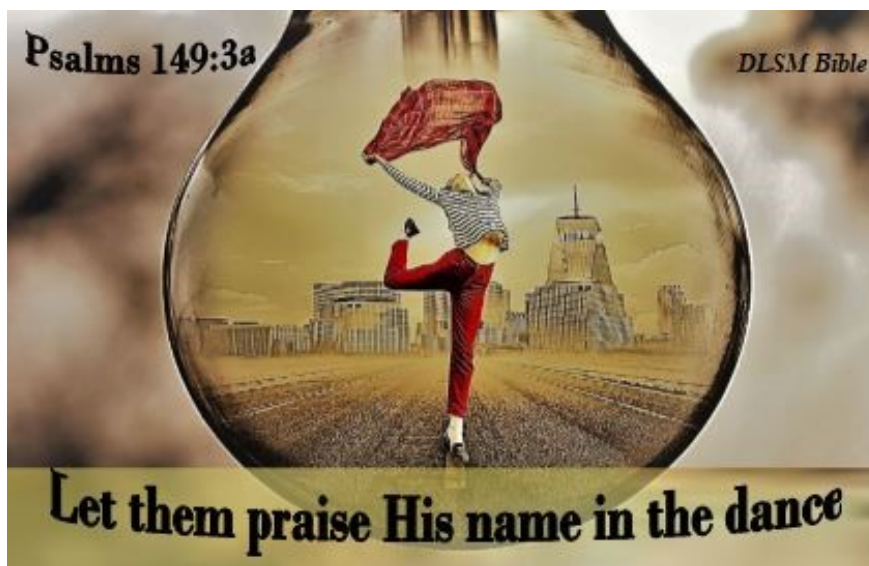

Paul Althus

Born: February 1888 Obershagen, Province of Hanover, German Empire

“Earthly regeneration is a parable, but just alone a parable of the things to come.”

Paul Althaus, was a German Lutheran theologian. Professor of systemic theology at the University of Göttingen. Althaus’s position was that God originally ordained marriage, family, work, economy, people, state, church and society not as orders of preservation, but as orders of creation since God continually works through them. Due to his works “The Theology of Martin Luther and “The Ethics of Martin Luther” Althaus is considered still to this day as one of the foremost experts of Martin Luther’s theology.

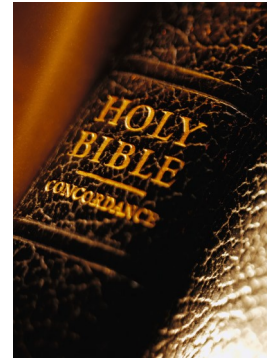

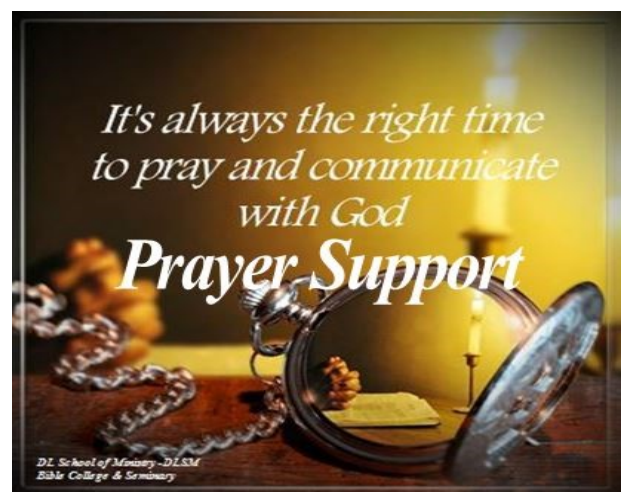

Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

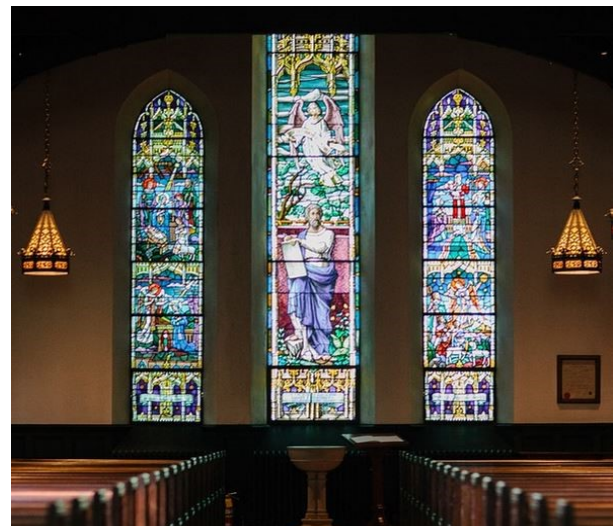

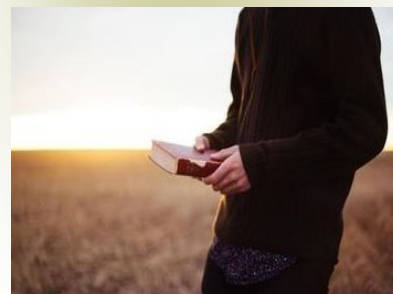
