COVID-19 forced us to cancel the April gathering of 100+ Women Who Care, and we don't want to risk anyone's health by planning an in-person July get-together. But the mission of 100+ Women is to support local nonprofits, and a pandemic isn't going to stop us from doing exactly that. There's even a silver lining!

Here's the plan:

- **Nominations:** By July 1, local nonprofits are invited to go to <https://www.100womenwhocaremonadnock.com/charity-nomination.html> and submit nominations.
- **Drawing:** On July 2, we'll draw the names of 6 of the nominated charities at random.
- **Presentations:** Each of the 6 will be invited to create a 5-minute video, post it on YouTube, make it public, and share the link with the Charity Nominations Manager.
- **Viewing:** On July 10, links to all of the videos will be shared with WWC members, along with a link to each organization's website and another link to cast your vote.
- **Questions:** Through July 13, members will have an opportunity to ask questions of the charities via comments on the YouTube videos.
- **Voting:** Through July 15, each member will have a chance to vote for 2 of the 6 charities via a link to SurveyMonkey—one vote representing what would have been the choice for April, and one for July.
- **Tabulating:** By July 16, votes will be tabulated and the top 2 vote getters announced.
- **Donating:** Each WWC member will be asked to write 2 checks for \$50—one to each of the top 2 vote getters—and mail them to the Steering Committee by July 30.
