Application for Admissions
Checklist and FAQ Sheet

Checklist

Required Documents:

- State Issued Identification/Driver's License for each household member over the age of 18
- Social Security Cards for each household member
- Tribal Enrollment Card or Certificate of Indian Blood for each household member
- Birth Certificates for all household members under the age of 18

Proof of Income:

- Three (3) months' worth of paychecks for all employed
- Award letters for unearned income (SSI, TANF, unemployment, SSA, general assistance, child support etc.)
- Self-Certification/Statement of No Income (if applicable)

Please make sure you have all required documents and proof of income. Any missing documentation will slow down the application process.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can apply?

Any adult age 21 or older who is a member of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe can apply for any of the three (3) programs listed below.

What if I have no income?

In order to qualify, you must be income eligible based on the income limits within the county you reside in.

What if I am over income?

You would not be eligible for the assistance Programs Summit Lake offers; however, we may be able to find you alternate assistance depending on the program you applied for.

I have applied. How long will it take to be approved/denied?

As long as all required documents and proof of income has been submitted, your application can then be processed. Once all information has been verified the application will then be submitted to the council at the next scheduled council meeting. A letter will be mailed within the 10 business days following the meeting informing you whether you are approved or denied.
