Aaron A. Faupel age 86, retired Elkton area farmer died Thursday, February 5, at his home in Bradenton, FL.

He was born December 8, 1911 at the home of his parents the late Justus and Amanda (Knechtel) Faupel in Oliver Township.

On July 9, 1938 he was united in marriage to Fern M. Heckroth at her parents home near Gott's Corner.

Mr. Faupel farmed most of his life in Oliver Twp. In 1972, he retired but stayed on the farm until he sold it in 1984. That year, he and Fern moved to Florida.

He was a former member of the Evangelical United Brethren Church, Elkton and the Elkton United Methodist Church where in had served on the board and taught Sunday school many years. He also served on the Elkton School Board in the fifties, as president for 5 years.

Three brothers, Roy, Warner and Ervin and two sisters, Fidelia Milholin and Dorothy Faupel preceded him in death.
