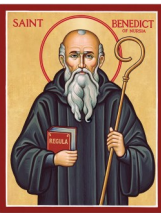

JULY 11 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT BENEDICT, ABBOT: Benedict decided on a life of solitude at a young age. He received the monastic habit and retired to a cave, where he lived alone in the tradition of the Desert Fathers. Soon he attracted followers and he built twelve small monasteries for those who wished to share his life. Later, he and a few companions founded the great monastery of Monte Cassino where Benedict spent the rest of his life and wrote his *Rule* which is still followed today by the Benedictines. The *Rule* emphasizes moderation, humility, obedience, prayer and manual labour as the way to holiness. Saint Benedict is considered the Father of Western monasticism

and was proclaimed a patron of Europe in 1964 by Pope Paul VI.

JULY 15 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT BONAVENTURE, BISHOP, DOCTOR: Born in Tuscany in 1221, Bonaventure joined the Friars Minor at age 20 and was sent to the University of Paris where he studied and then taught the philosophy and theology of the Franciscan school. In 1257 he was chosen minister general of the Franciscan Order, and in 1273 he was appointed a Cardinal by Pope Gregory X. He was known for his holiness, humility and virtue, and the dedication of his intellectual gifts to the service of the Church. His writings on Saint Francis, as well as on history, spirituality and medieval mystical doctrine, continue to inspire readers today. In 1482 he was canonized, and in 1588 he was declared a Doctor of the Church.
