

Mrs. Hugh McEachern

Passed Away April 7th

1933

Elizabeth Shaw MacEachern was born July 1, 1850, at Epson, Ontario, and died April 7, 1933, at the home of her son, Eachern MacEachern, at the age of eighty-two years, nine months and six days.

Elizabeth Shaw was united in marriage March 18, 1874, to Hugh McEachern of Eldon, Ontario, where they resided until 1876, when they moved to Souletown, in Chandler township where they lived until they retired from the farm and moved to Elkton in 1899.

To this union were born seven children, five of whom are surviving: two daughters, Sarah Heinze, of Royal Oak, and Catherine Grumney, of Cleveland, Ohio; three sons, John of Pontiac; Eachern of Elkton, and Hugh, Jr., of Hermansville, Mich; five grandsons, eleven granddaughters, five great grandchildren and three sisters, Mrs. George Smith, Mrs. John Rolfe and Mrs. John Strong of Elkton.

Funeral services were held Monday at the Elkton Methodist church. Rev. Ralph Harper officiating. Interment was made in Colfax cemetery.
