NORMAN W. SNIDER, Elkton — Mr. Snider, 74, Sarasota, Fla., retired farmer and former resident of the Elkton area, died Monday night at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Louis Spaeth, near Elkton, after suffering a heart attack. Born March 20, 1889, in Chandler Township, Huron County, he lived in this vicinity until about 12 years ago when he moved to Sarasota. He came about three weeks ago to visit his daughter. He is survived by two sons, Stanley and Elmer, both of Detroit; two daughters, Mrs. Earl Dibb, Fresno, Calif., and Mrs. Spaeth; 22 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren, a sister, Mrs. Mary Quackebush, Lupton, Mich., and four brothers, Arthur and Clayton, both of Bad Axe; Floyd, Caseville, and Blake, Saginaw. His wife, the former Miss Mabel Gilbert, whom he married in 1909, died Dec. 21, 1962. Funeral services for Mr. Snider will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Elkton Methodist Church. Rev. Frank Greer will officiate with Masonic burial rites to be conducted at Colfax Cemetery, near Bad Axe. Remains are in the Colgan Funeral Chapel and will be removed to the church at noon Thursday. Mrs. Snider was buried in Souletown Cemetery and her remains will be reinterred in Colfax Cemetery.
