AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO ORDINANCE: 0-2013-43

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES & OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2013 FOR AMELIA VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the Village is required by statute to prepare and adopt annual permanent appropriations of Village revenues for current expenses and other expenditures for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013;

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2013, the Village Council adopted O-2013-13 authorizing the permanent appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures during fiscal year 2013; and

WHEREAS, supplemental appropriations are necessary at this time, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of Amelia Village during said fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Amelia Village Council as follows;

SECTION I It is necessary to provide for additional expenditures of Amelia Village for Contractual Services, Supplies, Materials, and Capital Projects during the year ending December 31, 2013, the following amounts be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

SECTION II That there be appropriated from the Fire/EMS Levy Fund:

Account Code Account Name Supplemental Appropriations 2901-800-550-0000 Motor Vehicles \$35,000.00

To Account for the purchase and outfitting of Safety Services Vehicles.

SECTION IV Village Council finds these supplemental appropriations are necessary to provide sufficient funds for the several obligations of the Village.

SECTION V the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to make the supplemental appropriations as outlined in this Ordinance.

SECTION VI This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.

SECTION VII That the Amelia Village Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and, that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in the formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
