Originally from Miami, Florida, Ms. Mahone has over eighteen years of higher education fundraising experience. She currently serves as the Vice President for Institutional Advancement at Virginia State University where she is responsible for executing the fundraising and constituent engagement strategies, which advances the mission and vision of the University through philanthropy.

Prior to joining Virginia State University, Ms. Mahone served as the Associate Vice President for Development for Spelman College and held other roles at Spelman College including the Director of Annual Giving and a Leadership Gifts Officer. During her tenure at Spelman College, she established the Every Woman...Every Year! alumnae fundraising campaign where alumnae participation grew from 16% to 41%, supported the successful completion of the Campaign for Spelman College which raised over \$157M and implemented programs and infrastructure which increased donors and revenue from all constituent groups.

Other institutions Ms. Mahone has severed, include the University of Miami School of Law, Georgia State University, the University of Central Florida and the University of Florida.

Ms. Mahone earned a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Business Administration (concentration in Information Sciences) from the University of Florida, a Master of Business Administration from the University of Central Florida, and is a Certified Fundraising Executive (CFRE).
