LOWLANDS (LIGHT)

AUCHENTOSHEN 21 YEAR, 24

ELEGANT AND SMOOTH, AROMAS OF SOFT GREEN FRUIT WITH OAK AND FRESHLY CUT BARLEY; SWEET CHOCOLATY MINT WITH OAK AND HONEY ON THE PALATE; A LONG, SOFT, AND WARM FINISH.

AUCHENTOSHEN CLASSIC, 8

SOFT, RICH AND CREAMY WITH VANILLA, FRESH GREEN APPLE SKIN AND A LITTLE MINT; A WONDERFUL LONG, FRESH, FLORAL, ZESTY FINISH.

SPEYSIDE (SUBTLE & SMOOTH)

GLENFIDDICH 30, 50

A RARITY: BEAUTIFULLY STYLED, WITH NOTES OF SHERRY AND FIG. SEDUCTIVELY WOODY WITH A DARK CHOCOLATE, EMPHASIZED BY A FLORAL SWEETNESS WITH A VERY LONG, HONEYED WARM AFTERTASTE.

BALVENIE PORT WOOD 15 YEAR, 16

A DEFINED MALT OF REMARKABLE CHARACTER, IT IS CREAMY AND SILKY WITH FRUIT, HONEY, AND SPICE NOTES; A LONG AND GENTLE NUTTY FINISH, THERE ARE BEAUTIFULLY RICH PORT NOTES IN THIS WHISKEY.

ABERLOUR A'BUNADH, 16

SHERRIED WITH PRUNES, DATES, SULTANAS, PRESERVED PEARS, CARAMEL, AND A WONDERFUL SMOKY AROMA NOT TYPICAL OF MANY SPEYSIDE MALTS: A HOUSE FAVORITE.

GLEN FIDDICH 12 YEAR, 8

DISTINCTIVELY FRESH AND FRUITY WITH A HINT OF PEAR AND SUBTLE PINE, AND A HINT OF PEATINESS. THE 'WORLD'S BEST-SELLING SINGLE MALT' HAS A SATISFYING LONG, LINGERING AND ROUNDED FINISH.

HIGHLANDS (SMOOTH)

THE MACALLAN 18 YEAR, 24

A SOFT, RICH MALT WITH HINTS OF CITRUS, TROPICAL FRUITS, SPICE, AND WOOD SMOKE; A LINGERING FINISH WITH HINT OF ORANGE ZEST.

OBAN 14 YEAR, 15

A BALANCING ACT OF SALT, SWEETNESS AND SMOKE, WITH NOTES OF CITRUS WITH SMOOTH SWEETNESS, THE SMOKE MINGLES WITH NOTES OF SEAWEED SIMILAR TO THAT OF ISLAND WHISKEYS.

THE MACALLAN 12 YEAR, 10

IT HITS THE NOSE WITH A BLAST OF SHERRY; SHERRY CONTINUES ON THE PALATE, WITH PLUM BECOMING MORE DOMINANT, THEN FADES TO A NICE LEATHERY FLAVOR, WITH A LINGERING HINT OF CREAM. THE FINISH IS LONG, WITH TOFFEE NOTES AND SLIGHT SMOKINESS.

ISLAND (PEATY & SALTY)

TALISKER 18 YEAR,16

SALT AND PEPPER ARE STILL EVIDENT, BUT SOFTER AND SWEETER THAN THE 10 YEAR; SMOKEY, WHICH NICELY COUNTERBALANCES ITS FRUITINESS.

TALISKER 10 YEAR, 9

IT EXPLODES ONTO THE PALATE, BALANCING MELLOW FRUIT WITH SALTY FLAVORS AND A TINGLE OF PEPPER ON THE FINISH.

ISLAY (EVEN MORE PEATY & SALTY)

LAGAVULIN 16 YEAR, 16

PEATY, SALTY, AND SMOKY-EVERYTHING YOU WOULD EXPECT FROM AN ISLAY MALT, IT IS A BEAUTIFUL CLASSIC.

CAOL ILA 12 YEAR, 12

ONE OF THE LIGHTEST TASTING ISLAY MALTS, BUT WITH A HEALTHY, PEATY, MEDICINAL WAFT COMING THROUGH, IT IS LIGHT AND CRISP, WITH CITRUS FRUITS, AND A SLIGHT, OILY SMOKE: A SLIGHT TANG TO THE FINISH.
