Above: We are very thankful to our Lord for this unexpected blessing. We were with American visitors Ron and Sarah in November, and were visiting some of the Manna Program elderly and handicapped in the village of Reddipalem. The pastor, Prabakhar Rao, took us to see this girl, whom we did not even know was in the village. Because both parents were still working, the pastor didn't request help from the MP. Her father now has paralysis. Her name is Kumari, stricken with polio as a very small child. Her legs are very small and deformed, and she cannot sit up. Now a believer, but most of her young life she has been bedridden. Sarah asked us to inquire about the possibilities of Kumari being able to sit up, and also about helping her to have her own little shop to earn some income. The medical inquiries haven't yet been done, but the Lord guided us to get this cycle rickshaw. She sits as well as she can, and with the help of her mother is doing business!



CHILDREN'S PROFILES

Jeri (1-26-10, Morning Star): Jeri's mother died when she was a baby, leaving the father with 2 boys and 2 girls. He did not marry for 3 years, then married a widow who had 3 sons and 1 daughter of her own. Doesn't make sense, but this poor man's family now had 8 children. Shortly after their marriage, Jeri's Dad died, leaving this woman as a widow a 2nd time, this time with 8 kids! After his death, she was not willing to care for his 4 children. Not sure what happened with the other 3, but Jeri was brought to us through one of the Morning Star pastors.



Suvarna (born 5-30-10, HOPE): We have some children here at HOPE, whose parent or relative has really stupid reasons for leaving their child or not wanting to take responsibility. This one perhaps goes over the top. Because of the bad behavior, adultery with the mother's sister, and alcoholism of Suvarna's father, the mother took her and another child to stay with the grandparents in a different village. While in that village this 5 year old was raped by a 20 year old boy. When the father heard about it, he took the girl from that village, brought her to his village, and filed a case on the young man. So for several months this girl has been staying with her aunt (father's sister). Suvarna's father wants to kill the young man who raped her, but also wishes Suvarna would die. Why? Because her rape has brought much shame and embarrassment to him. A very bold and active child who needs a lot of patience, training and the Lord's healing in her heart. *Read Psalms 147:3*

Left: Hope you can enlarge this some way to see their beautiful faces, but this is the HOPE children (2 older girls missing) in one of 3 new dresses provided for them at Christmas. We are so thankful for the Father's provision! Also, we had asked you to pray about helpers for our new widows home. We believe His timing has come, as a Godly pastor and his wife have come forward. We'll keep you updated. Also asked you to pray about new tires for the school van, and He's provided thru His people. Hallelujah!



Above: The Morning Star Girls Home was needing a water supply on their compound, and a gracious donor provided. Here a truck is drilling for what they call a "tube well", which has a hand pump on the ground surface, but goes deep. Probably not any different than some of our pumps and wells in America. Now they should have sufficient water! "The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food in due time." Psalms 145:15 That's how it works: we cry to Him, He hears, and in His time provides the answers.

We asked you to pray about struggles in getting funds to the Morning Star. We believe the Lord has shown us a way, but must walk through the process to see how it works. Pray for His favor. Pray for the MS leaders, as they are being engulfed with useless govt. (and Satanic) requirements.

Below: Precious HOPE School girls (4th to 6th grades), happy to receive new uniforms. Sadly, their parents don't take responsibility for these girls' education (mostly it's the father, who'd rather drink their education away). So for these girls, and many others in our HOPE School, they are from poor families, sometimes Hindu families. All these girls are from so-called Christian homes, but even though our fees are very low: between \$80 and \$160 a year per child (this includes books, uniforms and transportation for those who need it), still their parents don't take their education seriously. Look at them! Could you do that? The Lord led us to provide uniforms for these girls; we'll see how much the parents will pay later. Our commitment is to love them and teach them, also about Him. We have about 60 poor children like these. **Pray** for sponsors (total amount is about \$600 a month).



MANNA PROGRAM PROFILES

MEKHALA (Morning Star MP): Her husband was a daily laborer in their village, they having one daughter. One day a major persecution of Christians took place (in 2008). Their house was burnt down and they lost everything. They were in the jungle for some days without food. While there the man became very sick. Because of fear, they did not try to leave the jungle for a hospital. When a relief camp was started some days later, another believer helped him to a hospital, but he died in the hospital. Now she is staying with her daughter, but without these extra MP funds it is very difficult for her to care for all the needs of her and the girl.



ANJANEYULU (Krupa Colony MP): He is in his 70's, his wife still living (also in Manna Program). They had 6 children, but 3 of them have died somehow. The other 3 do not care for them sufficiently. Both husband and wife are working as vessel cleaners (pots, pans, dishes, etc.) for one family. This family was also giving them a little food. A very poor man, has come to Christ; has many health problems. Please pray for he and his wife.

Below: This is Bro. Prabhakar Rao (not as rough as he looks) giving a new Christmas dress to Lakshmi, who previously was staying in our HOPE home. When Bro. Russel (from Oklahoma) was with us in January, we had a great meeting with most of our Manna Program widows, elderly and handicapped, calling them all to the home for a time of prayer, singing, hearing GOD's Word, distributing new clothes and eating a meal. All six of the pastors who are overseeing the different MPs in the HOPE area and surrounding villages came to this meeting. We hope to do this at least once annually.

Continue to pray that the "Defender of widows" and He Who "makes a home for the lonely" (Psalms 68:5-6) will touch many more hearts to assist in the physical and spiritual outreach to these very needy people. Already this year 3 monthly donors have stopped their donations for the MP poor for financial reasons (almost \$200 a month). Our eyes are upon Him (Psalms 123:1-2).
