**FOXBORO - SHARON COUNCIL 6063 SCHOLARSHIP**  
**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND LIMITATIONS**

- ◆ The scholarship is \$1000.
- ◆ Eligibility is limited to Members of Foxboro – Sharon Council 6063 and their immediate family members. Immediate family shall include: spouse, children, stepchildren, and grandchildren.
- ◆ The Brother Knight through whom the applicant is claiming eligibility must be a member in good standing (dues current), presently or have been a member in good standing at the time of his death, and also have been a member of Council 6063 for a minimum of 12 months prior to application.
- ◆ The applicant must have completed the first year of study at an accredited college, university or community college at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- ◆ Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college, university or community college.
- ◆ A three-member committee, appointed by the Grand Knight, will select the winner. No Brother Knight either himself an applicant or having an immediate family member as an applicant may serve on the committee.
- ◆ The applications will be presented to the committee anonymously, identified by a number. Each committee member shall select the five most deserving applications and grade them 1 through 5. (1 being the most deserving.) The committee members will then compare and discuss the results of their grading and select a winner by consensus.
- ◆ The committee will select the most deserving applicant based on financial need, academic standing and career/life goals.
- ◆ No person may be awarded the scholarship more than once.
