They are going to look into what would look more favorable.

We did apply for the CDBG Year 46 grant for the B Street storm sewer project. That came in that it would be funded with the borough's share would be about \$25,000. We

got word that the project would be fully funded with no cost to the borough other than additional work that we want to do.

Mr. Zrenchak stated that we have been trying to fill some vacancies on the Planning Board and the Zoning Board. We received 1 letter for each board. He asked that if anyone was interested in either board to please submit an application, resume or letter of interest to the borough. The other position we are looking to fill is the Chairman of the Vacancy board. He said we can advertise for those positions on Savvy Citizen.
