Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

Presiding Commissioner Kyle Carroll made the motion to accept the agenda as presented and the minutes from the meeting of the 20th of May with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

The meeting concerning Economic Development to be held in Cameron on the 29th of May will be attended by East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

SB190 (Senior Tax Credit) was discussed. West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the motion to put the Senior Tax Credit question on the 2026 April ballot. The question would be do the patrons of DeKalb County wish for the Commission to put an ordinance in place to implement the Senior Tax Credit. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second. All in favor. White-aye, Carroll-aye and Owen-aye. Motion carried 3-0. If the issue passes in April of 2026 the Commission would pass the ordinance immediately with applications being accepted soon thereafter. The base year for the ordinance would be 2024. Currently DeKalb County does not have the software necessary for implementation and the tax book is currently in the process of being set with valuations going out to the entities the 1st of July.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll signed the contract for the vending machine. The machine should be installed in the next week or so.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee presented the adjustment register for the Commission & Clerk to review and sign.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White will attend a Tri-County Health meeting this Friday, May 30th.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll will attend a DDRJ meeting on Friday the 30th.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen will attend a meeting of the DeKalb County Extension on Monday June 2nd.
