

**Town of Stratton
Selectman's Meeting
March 9, 2026**

Present: Selectman: Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Boomer Walker; Clerk, Kent Young; and Town Attorney Robert Fisher.

7:30 pm: Chris Liller called the meeting to order. No modifications were made to the agenda.

Executive Session: Boomer Walker moved to enter Executive Session to discuss current and potential litigations involving the Town. Greg Marcucci seconded – all concurred and invited Attorney Robert Fisher and Clerk, Kent Young to attend the session.

At 8: 15pm Greg Marcucci moved to exit Executive Session. Boomer Walker seconded – all concurred. The session ended – no decisions were made. Following this session, Robert Fisher left the meeting.

Orders were reviewed and signed.

Organizational: The Selectmen agreed to the following organization of the Board:

- 2) Larry Bills as Vice-Chairman
- 3) to place all necessary publications in the Brattleboro Reformer.
- 4) to hold regular Selectmen's meetings on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month at 7:30PM at the Stratton Town Office.
- 5) Town Office personnel will function as the Selectmen's secretary
- 6) to conduct meetings using Roberts Rules.

Boomer Walker so moved. Greg Marcucci seconded – all concurred.

Road Crew Issues: FLAP Grant: As part of said Grant, the Foreman asked that the Selectmen formally approve a *Cooperative Forest Road Agreement* to maintain the road and areas included with in the FLAP agreement. Greg Marcucci so moved. Boomer Walker seconded – all concurred. **Temporary Access Permit:** Pitts and Sons submitted a temporary access permit application for logging. The Access is on Stratton-Arlington Rd., approx. 300 ft east of the pull-off area at the top of Joe Jelly Hill. The Road Foreman approves of the site. Greg Marcucci so moved. Boomer Walker seconded – all concurred and signed the Temporary Access Permit. **FLEET:** The Selectmen approved a FLEET permit submitted by: G. W. Tatro Construction Inc. **Personnel Issues:** Chris Liller will be out on Medical Leave temporarily beginning on March 11, 2026. **Yearly Bids:** The Road Foreman would like to consider bids at the last meeting of April (April 27, 2026).

Annual Appointments: Boomer Walker moved to make the following appointments for the Town – ZBA members: the Board agreed to make the ZBA member appointments annually (previously three-year appointments) and appointed the following individuals to said Board: DR Holton, Boomer Walker; Greg Marcucci, Paul Bernard and Steve Fletcher. Emergency Management Director – Victor Rivas; Ethics Liaison – Candie Bernard; Dog Warden / Pound Keeper – Pat Salo; Tree Warden – Al Dupell; DVFiber Rep. – Dale Niederhauser and Alternate – Betsy Wadsworth; WSWM Rep. – Kent Young; WRC Reps – Renee Mulky and Erica Reynolds. Greg Marcucci seconded – all concurred and appropriate paperwork as needed was signed by the Acting Chair.

Town Hall Requests: The Selectmen reviewed and approved the following request: Missy Fitzpatrick for April 5, 2026 and Wadsworth Co. for April 15, 2026.
