



FISHING AND BOATING GUIDELINES



FISHING LICENSE: None required.

GUESTS:

- Residents may have a reasonable number but must remain with them.
- No lifeguards are on duty. Residents and guests use the lake facilities at their own risk.

WATERCRAFT:

- There is a boat launch adjacent to the north-south walkway.
- Kayaks, paddle boats, canoes and boats propelled manually or with electric motors are allowed.
- Paddleboards, surfboards, skim-boards, and rafts are not allowed as swimming and wading in the lake are prohibited.

BANK FISHING ALLOWED FROM:

- Seawall parallel to clubhouse.
- The boat launch when boats are not being launched or retrieved.
- Walkways to the gazebo.
- Finger pier around the gazebo.
- The dam parallel to Wolf Bay Drive.

NO PARKING:

- On the grass anywhere.
- On either side of Lake South Drive near the boat launch property.
- In or in front of any resident's driveway without the resident's permission.
- On the lake side of Wolf Bay Drive.
- On the bicycle lanes of Wolf Bay Drive or County Road 12.

FISH LIMITS:

- BASS: Release any 15 inches or larger. Keep any under 15 inches.
- PANFISH: Bream and Shellcracker; combined limit is 15 fish.
- CARP: Limit is 0 fish. Before releasing carp, be sure the fish is alive.
- CATFISH and EEL: Do not return any to the lake, regardless of size.

OTHER:

- **Do not feed the fish.** This changes the feeding habits of grass carp purchased to control grass growth in the lake. Violators subject to stiff fine.
- Jug fishing and Trot lines are prohibited.
- Do not leave fishing rods and/or poles with lines in the water unattended.
- Except when launching or retrieving watercraft, wading is not permitted.
- Dock lights should be low voltage and pointed down towards the water.
