

ARROW HEAD TYPES

Some of the many types of arrows and points used in archery today and yesteryear are listed below:

- Barbed A war or hunting arrow with a barbed head.
- Bearing A heavy arrow used in war also called a livery or sheaf arrow.
- Blunt A flat tipped arrow used for small game.
- Breasted An arrow that is largest in the cresting area.
- Bob-tail A tapered arrow larger at the nock end.
- Broadhead A wide bladed arrow with or without barbs.
- Bullet An arrow with a cupped head for shooting bullets or round stones.
- Barrelled An arrow thick in the centre and thinnest at the ends.
- Clout A light arrow used for shooting long distances.
- Target An arrow used in target archery which can be in various materials.
- Flight A very light piled arrow with small fletching used to shoot maximum range.
