# BVT Young Performer Summer Camps 2026 Descriptions

## AGES 7-10

### **Intro. to Theatre Camp (ages 7-10)**

July 8 1PM-4PM

Tuition: \$35

This course will be a “first step” for grade school children to get acquainted with the stage and performance. In this three-hour class, students will learn about basic stage etiquette, beginner improvisation, and scene work. The class will include theatre games that teach teamwork, listening, projection, and focus. Each student will get a short script to work on with a group to be performed during sharing time.

### **Playwriting Camp (ages 7-10)**

July 22th 9AM-12PM

Tuition: \$35

This course will focus on the writing of theatrical scenes. The class will play theatre games that focus on creative thinking, the art of storytelling, listening, and teamwork. The class will discuss the qualities of a good story and explore a few classic stories. Each student will be paired with a partner and together they will write a very short scene. These scenes will be performed at sharing time.

## AGES 11-18

### **Musical Theatre Camp (ages 11-18)**

July 14 9AM-3PM

Tuition: \$60

This advanced camp will focus on incorporating song into theatre. The performers will receive guidance on layering truth and technique into musical theatre. Each performer will be given a short cut of a solo piece to work on during the camp. Additionally, the camp participants will work on a choreographed group number. These pieces will be presented during sharing time.

*Students will be expected to bring a sack lunch. Bottles of water will be available for students each day.*

### **Improvisation Camp (ages 11-18)**

July 15 9AM-12PM

Tuition: \$35

This camp explores the fundamental aspects of improvisational theatre. Improvisation (Improv), in theatre, is defined as the performance of scenes without written dialogue and with minimal or no predetermined dramatic activity. The class will participate in theatrical warm-ups, learn the fundamentals of improvising scenes, and combine these skills in improv games that focus on listening, creative thinking, the art of storytelling, and teamwork. Each student will participate in numerous games, and work on long form improvisation (long unscripted scenes) which will be performed during sharing time.

### **Playwriting Camp (ages 11-18)**

July 22th 1PM-4PM

Tuition: \$35

This course will focus on the writing of theatrical scenes. The class will play theatre games that focus on creative thinking, the art of storytelling, listening, and teamwork. The class will explore storytelling for the stage and discuss the qualities of a good story. Students will be guided through the writing of a very short scene.

### **Acting & Auditioning Techniques Camp (ages 11-18)**

July 28th 9AM-12PM

Tuition: \$35

This camp will explore technique in auditioning and stage performance. Each student will explore elements of auditioning, including ways to combat stage fright and preparation. They will learn about acting resumes and headshots and other materials necessary for professional auditioning. Students will practice “cold readings” and use class time to work on an audition monologue to be performed during sharing time.

**Stage Movement Camp (ages 11-18)**

July 28 1-4PM

Tuition: \$35

This camp will focus on using the body and movement on the stage to communicate character and action. The course will include exercises in body control, body language, and movement techniques. It will also include some dance and stage combat to provide beginner movement skills for the growing performer. Students are encouraged to wear comfortable clothes that they can move in. Each student will work on a piece that demonstrates elements of stage movement which will be presented during sharing time.

**\*Intro. to Costumes (ages 11-18)**

July 29 9AM-12PM

Tuition: \$35

Have you ever been curious about clothing? Do you wonder how people change so quickly when they are backstage? Do you want to know more about fabric, textiles, jewelry, and more? This is the class for you! This three hour course explores jobs in the costume world, basics about theatrical costuming tricks, and a look into our costume storage. Students will get the opportunity to learn, ask questions, and make some design choices of their own. Pair this class with Sewing 101 for a full day of costume magic!

**\*Sewing 101 (ages 11-18)**

July 29 1PM-4PM

Tuition: \$35

Have you always wanted to learn how to sew? Did a button fall off your shirt and you need help putting it back on? Or hemming a pair of pants that is just too long or too short? Or maybe you have sewing knowledge and you want help with a project you are working on? This is the class for you! Students will learn sewing basics including hand sewing, machine sewing, serging, and ironing. Students with prior knowledge can also bring a project to work on with guidance as time allows. Pair this class with Intro. to Costumes for a full day of costume magic!
