Summer Reading

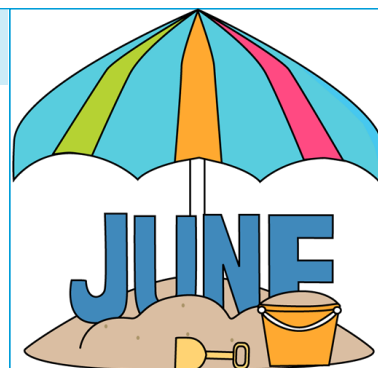
We will begin our Summer Reading programs in June. The main library and both of the branches will have different programs taking place throughout the month. The theme for this year's Summer Reading is "Build a Better World".

At the main library we will be having the Honey Hill Petting Zoo will be at the main library on Friday, June 9th from 12pm – 4pm. At the petting zoo there will be a live pony carousel and 12 petting zoo animals including a camel and kangaroo. There will also be outdoor fun and games taking place along with the petting zoo. At this program you can come and go as you please.

To kick off Summer Reading at our Cloverport branch there will be a cookout and Animal Tales: Animal Architects program on Tuesday, June 6th at 10am.
