We are excited to offer a guided tour of the Hydroplane Museum plus lunch BBQ on September 7th. The museum in Kent, WA features an incredible collection of vintage hydroplanes spanning seven decades, including boats that have won 17 Gold Cups.

Tour includes Museum, Restoration Shop, Gift shop, and a peek into the Engine Shop. You will also have a chance to sit in the cockpit of one of the Museum's historic hulls. Boats on display include the Slo Mo V, Miss Bardahl, Atlas Van Lines, Miss Wahoo, Notre Dame, Squire Shop, Miss Budweiser, and the 1971 Miss Madison currently undergoing restoration.

A \$15 fee must be received in the RCLEA PO Box by September 1, 2022. Registrations received after September 1st and at the door are \$20.00. Checks should be made payable to the Hydroplane and Raceboat Museum. (RCLEA receives no funds from this event.)

Guided Tour starts at 10:30 am. BBQ Lunch, cooked by the museum staff, starts at noon.
