BESPOKE CHARACTER ATTRIBUTES

Sean possesses a neurolinguistically augmented hyperspatial/hypervisual kineasthetic awareness, a latent ability flowered through a biochemical hardship, that allows Sean to become the hero NUKE.

Sean is a mid-twenties student who works two jobs and goes to community college part-time. Due to childhood obesity, he is overweight, with self-esteem issues that spill into his social life.

He has a strong relationship with his grandmother, who also works at the small gourmet grocer, where his brother works too. This is where we first meet Sean (before he transforms into “Nuke”).

In this environment there are over 20,000 SKU's, of which Sean, a stockkeeper, has a surprisingly intimate knowledge. He knows brand origins, product profiles, and uses cases for each inventory department, making him more of a food librarian than a grocer.

In addition to his highly verbal, encyclopedic knowledge of each inventory family, Sean has a unique talent, that approaches Olympian skill, when it comes to stocking shelves. His syncopated dexterities are part of the visual design of the grocery world, that transcends into both Warhol pop iconography (flying Campbell's soup cans,...), and foreshadowed grocery store based game show spaces.

Let's just say Sean has trigger fingers and a washboard forehead, when it comes to a job he has held for over a decade now. And the regulars rely on him, like the conceirge gourmand that he has become. But reality has something special planned for Sean, something that noone is expecting (a kind of surreal problem-solution video game he must travel through to save himself).

The sudden onset of inflammatory food allergies causes anaphylactic shock, one night while stocking a truck load of grocery shelves. Our hero, unknowing of his emergent condition, accidentally injects a food product, while on the night shift, that causes him to stop breathing.

Through sudden events, and assisted breathing by a hapless security guard, Sean's death is reversed by paramedics, leaving him in a temporary coma, during which his family must come to terms with the conditions that have led to this moment.

From the hospital, we gain access to the forces in Sean's life, the dietary causes and factors, which read like a list of felony charges, implicating each of his kin, family members who can no longer absolve themselves of any wrongdoing. Though, despite the looming uncertainty that Sean will ever pull through, they speculate a new future that must be arranged for rehabilitation, in which collectively they will change the family behavior around food. *And then Sean wakes up.*

With multiple food allergies, weight-height disproportion, stunted social and communication skills, and an unclear future ahead of him, Sean is granted a new beginning that he will have to navigate, through a character arc that takes him from a grocery store denizen, to a hospital, to a youtube channel, to a television studio game show set -- where Sean recalls a vision he had during his near-death experience, enabled by his very own personal talking cartoon avatar, **TORK**.

NOTE: Zac's presense as an actor possesses a range of emotive, vocal and kineasthetic layers, which are designed in this role to play against his recent "jock stereotype." With the role of Sean, aka "NUKE," these attributes are layered into an original character, whose transformative arc moves from psycho-noetic observer to imagineer-hero, with Sean's interior reality showcased through a cartoon persona, his avatar **TORK**. For the screenlife of "NUKE," Zac will have to transform from hunk to chub to incredible food genius.
