DESCRIPTION: This old Bear Cub from 1957 is still in great shape for its age. This is a semi-recurve, but qualifies as a long bow in the sense that the string doesn't touch the limbs when strung. Original leather grip. Shoot right or left handed. Arctic Gray face limbs, and black back limbs. Island Maple riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress cracks or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are still in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new black horse hair rug rest/side plate on both sides, and a slightly used but good Flemish string. This bow sold for \$24.50 in 1957, which translates to \$283 in 2025 inflation adjusted dollars.
