They can listen to your concerns, your story, pray with you and bring Holy Communion, if you wish. Usually each ward gets visited twice each week. But we do not know you are there if you do not let us know! (The Sacrament of the Sick can be asked for in the parish too!) Please make sure to do this for relatives or those in care too! People generally find comfort and strength from this ministry from the Church. On a recent day in Woking, our Bishop Richard stressed its importance.
