Registration for this event begins on January 7, 2019.



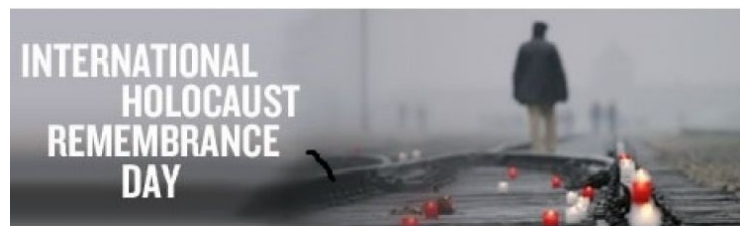
