#### Treasurer Report:

The club had \$489.84 in the checking account as of January 12 after placing an order for powder and flints that will be picked up at the Wyoming Winter Convention the weekend of January 19-20. The club has \$1,058 in a CD earning .04% interest.

#### Old Business:

The Wyoming Winter Convention will be January 19-20, 2019 in Caspar. Seven members are planning on going to the convention. Ride sharing is available if others want to go.

Deacon and Splinter are the co-leads for the January Shoot on January 21.

#### New Business:

Changes to Territorial Shoots – There won't be a National Territorial Shoot at Friendship, IN anymore. Your ranking at the national level will be determined by your scores at the Territorial event you attend. Other changes that will take place include weighing bench guns and weighing the trigger pull on muskets before firing the event. Additionally, shooters won't be able to buy into 4 aggregates and shoot a 5<sup>th</sup> aggregate for free anymore. Because of the weight constraints on bench guns and musket triggers, please consider helping out during the shoots.

Colorado Territorials will be held June 14-16, 2019 in Fort Lupton at the SPVHS range at 2001 History Parkway, Fort Lupton, CO 80621.

The course of fire for the day included 4 rifle targets at 25 yards and a gong set at 50 yards. Shooters took 5 shots at each of the 4 targets at 25 yards, 5 shots at the 50-yard gong, and 1 shot at a tie-breaker target set at 25 yards.

The match started around 10am and was over by 1pm. The weather was changing throughout the shoot, going from warm and sunny to windy, cold and cloudy, and then back to sunny. Coats were being taken off and then put back on during the course of the morning and lots of coffee/tea was consumed between shots thanks to the cold breeze. Bushwhacker caused a bit of a stir when he moved one of Stitches' and Many Trails' guns over to his pickup while nobody was looking; everybody got a chuckle out of this bit of tomfoolery. Everybody had a good time in spite of the cool temperatures; smiles and laughter were a large part of the day.
