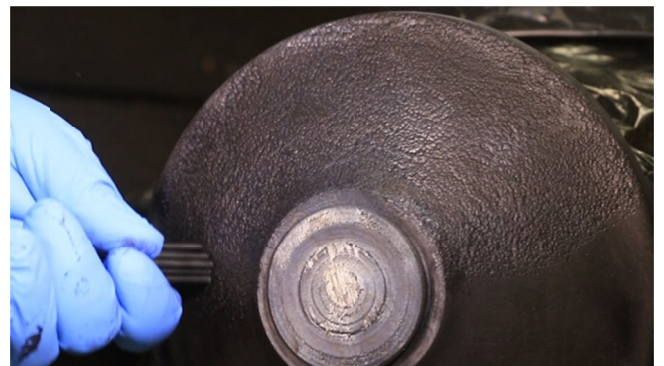
In this demonstration we'll cover several topics which will help to better illustrate all of the facets of turning a No Sand or Low Sand - Textured & Dyed Platter.

We'll cover mounting the blank with a worm screw, the proper way to cut, size and use tenons when using a scroll chuck insuring stability and safety. I'll demonstrate roughing, scraping, riding the bevel for clean cutting and sheer scraping to clean up any humps bumps and ridges left behind from proper cutting.

Dry Hard Maple (could use any solid hardwood) 2" or 3" thick x 8" – 10" diameter

Woodturners Wonders 4 in 1 – 8" CBN Wheels 80 & 180 - \$169.95 per wheel – woodturnerswonders.com

Harbor Freight Compact Needle Scaler - \$29.99 - Item#96997

Needles rounded to make smoother stippling

DO NOT USE CBN WHEELS – these needles are mild steel and will harm your CBN wheels.

I used stone wheels to round the needles.

Homemade Airbrush Cleaner

Pint Recipe

50% - Windshield Washer Fluid

25% - Distilled Water

25% - Denatured Alcohol

½ teaspoon – Glycerin

Golden Fluid Acrylic Paint 1 Ounce-Iridescent Copper www.amazon.com

Old Fashioned Milk Paint – <http://www.milkpaint.com/> can be bought at Woodcraft, Amazon etc.

Best mixed with warm water to break down quicker.

Stir, stir and stir some more.

Let set for 10 minutes – stir some more and more for smoother texture

Can store in cool for up to two days – if you're lucky
