1894 - 1981

Clarence J. Larson, age 86, of Saginaw passed away Sunday, Sept. 20 at Gladwin Area Hospital, following a lengthy illness. He was born Oct. 29, 1894 in Freesoil, Mich., and served with the U.S. Army Tank Corps during World War I.

He married Buelah E. Quick of Bay Port on Aug. 21, 1924. She preceded him in death on Jan. 29, 1964. He was employed at Saginaw Grey Iron Foundry and was a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

He was united in marriage to Ida Mae Hill on Oct. 10, 1964. He is survived by his wife, Ida Mae; one son, Jack Larson of Lansing, and one step-daughter, Vivian Kintner of Beaverton. A son, Duane, preceded him in death on March 6, 1963. Three other sons predeceased him in infancy.

Mr. Larson is also survived by a former daughter-in-law, Irma Ruiz of Saginaw, one brother, David W. Larson of Florida, several grandchildren, nieces and nephews and many other relatives in the Bay Port and Pigeon area.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday, Sept. 22 at 1 p.m. from the Case Chapel, Saginaw. Elder Harold McAllister of Beaverton officiated. Memorial service, at the Bay Port RLDS Church, 3 p.m., burial in the New Bay Port Cemetery.
