Dear friends, welcome to the celebration of Easter Sunday of Jubilee Year 2025. “Jesus Christ is Risen Today Alleluia” is our song and greeting on this Easter Sunday morning. Our Lenten journey that started on Ash Wednesday brings us to the Glorious Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
