Regards: Rowan's Law Implementation

The Ayr Minor Soccer Club is in full support of the intent of Rowan's Law to create awareness of concussion, change the culture on concussion and provide safe sport participation.

As of July 1, 2019, every Player, Team Official and On-Field Official (parent as well if individual is under 18) in order to register/participate must review the Ayr Soccer Club Concussion Code of Conduct and the appropriate Concussion Awareness Resources.

## Requirements

- All Registrants registering July 1, 2019 or after must have completed the review information and acknowledgement prior to registration/participation.
- All Team Officials currently registered will be required to complete the review of information and acknowledgement prior to August 30, 2019.
- All Registrants registered prior to July 1, 2019 must complete the review of information and acknowledgement prior to participation in the first game.

The Ayr Minor Soccer Club has provided the following method to validate that the Players and Team Officials that Register with the Ayr Minor Soccer Club have acknowledgement of the Club's Concussion Code of Conduct and the Ontario Governments Concussion Awareness Resources.

- Players and Parents/Guardians will be required to review the material on-line during the registration process and sign the Ayr Minor Soccer Club's Acknowledgement form for Rowan's Law prior to being eligible to Register/participate.
- All Team Officials and On-Field Officials will be required to review the material in person and sign the Ayr Minor Soccer Club's Acknowledgement form for Rowan's Law prior to being eligible to participate.
- It will be the responsibility of the Ayr Minor Soccer Club to retain a hard copy of the Rowan's Law Acknowledgement Form for a period of 7 years for each Registered Participant.
