USGA Rules Govern All Play Local Rules


- · Out of bounds is defined by white stakes and boundary fences.
- Paved cart paths and curbs are deemed to be obstructions. Drop without penalty, within one club length of nearest point of relief no nearer to the hole.
- Wetlands and environmentally sensitive areas are defined as lateral hazards (Rule 26-1). Golf balls may be retrieved but not played from designated wetland areas.
- Water hazards defined by yellow stakes and/or lines. Lateral hazards defined by red stakes and/or lines. Penalty and relief under Rule 26-1.
- If a ball strikes the power line or pole during play of the 5th hole, the stroke is canceled, and the player shall play a ball as near as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played.

GOLF CLUB

• If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, the ball shall be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club length of nearest point of relief, no nearer to the hole (Rule 24-26i).

General Information

- Golf carts shall be kept on cart paths around tees and greens.
- · Please "keep pace" with group in front of you and allow group to play through if more than one hole is clear ahead of you.
- · Golf Course Ranger has authority to govern all play.
- · Yardages are measured to the center of the green.
- · Restrooms are located at the green on hole #4 and #6, at the turn and at the
