

Looking forward to seeing everyone soon and an exciting year ahead.



This month we continue to highlight those who have been inducted into the NCM's **Corvette Hall of Fame**. Inductees' full bios are available on the Museum's **Corvette Hall of Fame** pages.



Noland Adams is a well-known author and Corvette historian whose works include a series of technical books; he hosted a series of restoration videotapes, written hundreds of articles for Corvette related magazines, and has given numerous presentations on Corvette restoration all over the United States, plus seminars in Canada, Sweden and England. He is known world-

In June 1987 Ray Battaglini wrote to the chairman of the recently formed NCRS Library, Archives and Museum Committee, volunteering his services to help 'develop plans and strategies' for a museum. Seven years later, the National Corvette Museum was a reality, thanks in no small measure to Battaglini himself. He had been a teenage hot-rodder

cruising the streets of San Leandro, California when he fell in love with the Corvette. In 1963 he bought a brand-new Split-Window Coupe. Once a wife and kids moved into the picture, though, the Corvette moved out. In 1957 Yenko bluffed his way into his first competition race using his new V-8 Corvette. He was hooked and he convinced his father to sponsor his racing...and was soon entering his Corvette in various SCCA events. Cofounding the Corvette Club of Western Pennsylvania provided a boost to his racing career when the club recruited the vice-

president of Gulf Oil. Gulf agreed to sponsor two Corvettes for the 1961 racing season and Yenko and Dick Thompson were hired to drive. For the next three years the Gulf Oil Corvettes dominated the A and B Production classes. Sadly, Don Yenko died in a plane crash in 1987. Read more about Don Yenko at



1954 'Entombed' Corvette Donated to Museum: this story first appeared in the November 7th edition of NCM eNews and is reprinted here with the permission of the National Corvette Museum.



It was 1954 and successful business man, Richard Sampson of Brunswick, Maine had just purchased a brand-new Corvette. After driving it for four years, he wanted to park it somewhere safe. Sampson was constructing new stores for his grocery chain and decided one of them would be the perfect structure to keep his car secure. A tomb was built inside the store – literally around his Corvette. Sampson specified in his will that the car was not to be taken out of the man-made 'time-capsule' until the year 2000. Although Sampson changed his wishes before he passed away in 1969, the car remained entombed for 27 years.

As previously mentioned, Jordan Taylor has joined Corvette Racing on a full-time basis starting with the Rolex 24 At Daytona in the GT Le Mans (GTLM) category. The race takes place January 25-26. Jordan will share driving duties of the No. 3 C8.R car with Antonio Garcia. The No. 3 Corvette C8.R will feature a yellow livery with silver accents.

In the No. 4 C8.R Corvette, silver with yellow accents, Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner reunite for the ninth consecutive season, making them the longest-running driver pairing currently in IMSA. They've won 14 races and two IMSA titles together, the most recent in 2016.

Prior to the 24, the team will participate in *The Roar Before the 24* on January 2-5, an obligatory three-day test serving as the final dress rehearsal before the Rolex 24 race. Access to cars and drivers at the pre-season extravaganza is an event trademark. Corvette race fans will see the public debut of the new C8.R Corvettes and their new livery.

As you know, the team participates in three endurance races each season, in addition to the *24 Hours of Le Mans* races. They run 24 hours (at Daytona), 12 hours (at Sebring) and 10 hours (at Petit Le Mans). The length of these endurance race requires a third driver for each car and in past seasons Jordan Taylor has been that third driver in the No. 3.

For 2020, a new face joins Corvette Racing for these endurance races. Nicky Catsburg has competed in series like IMSA, the FIA World Endurance Championship and World Touring Car Championship, among others. He also drove the Corvette C6.R during the FIA GT1 World Championship and

the Corvette C7.R during testing for the 24 Hours of Le Mans.

Marcel Fässler returns, for the fifth consecutive season, to join Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner for all three of IMSA's premier endurance races in the No. 4 Corvette C8.R. He won at Daytona and Sebring during the 2016 season with Gavin and Milner and in addition to 2009 duties with Corvette Racing, Fässler also is a three-time overall winner of the 24 Hours of Le Mans and is a past World Drivers Champion in the FIA WEC. His experience in Corvette race cars dates back more than a decade.

We wish Corvette Racing a very successful season and look forward to seeing them in July at CTMP!!


