Frederick G. Liston, 85 of Pigeon, died unexpectedly Tuesday, Nov. 19 in McKinley Township.

He was born Dec. 10, 1910 in Alcona Township, Alcona Co., to the late Daniel and Josephine (LaLonde) Liston.

On Aug. 31, 1948, he was united in marriage to Veronica V. Zielinski in Detroit. Mr. Liston was employed for 28 years with Pontiac Local #29, Brick Layer Union, as a brick layer, retiring to Sand Point in 1973.
