There is a great difference in the archery tackle requirements of the archer who shoots for recreation and the one who aspires to be a champion, or between the roving stump shooter and the big game trophy hunter.

You and your family can enjoy years of recreational shooting with a modest outfit such as a Cub Bow, a Spartan Armguard, Master glove, and a Mohican Quiver. The Cub is a composite bow (laminated of wood and fiberglass) and as such has the feel and action of the best bows—tremendous performance for the money. Wooden arrows of cedar such as the Standard Grade are the best for the first few weeks of shooting, when arrows have a habit of disappearing. Soon you will want more closely spine-matched High Grades or even spine and weight matched Top Grades which are even more accurate.

As your shooting improves you'll need that extra help better equipment can give. Graduate to A-20 arrows and a Polar® Bow or even better the famed Kodiak® Special. At this time, you will be doing enough shooting to appreciate the convenience of a Tournament quiver and the smoothness of a Pro glove.

Finally, when you're ready to go after those Championship scores, let the Tamerlane help you. The Tamerlane is designed and proven to give you every assist possible—balance, stability, speed and the Positive Position Grip. Tamerlane with matched Bear Easton or glass arrows will actually smooth out the variations in your shooting technique to give you the tightest groups on target possible. As an experienced archer, you will know which Bear accessories complement your style to improve your score. You might find that the ultra-clean release of a fresh Pre-furred Tab and the loose, stable grip permitted by a bow sling adds the 10 points between first and fourth place. And since good shots are notoriously hard on nocks, you will probably want a Trophy Quiver to carry a good supply of fresh arrows so you can finish a full day's shooting.

Of course the finest equipment improves the accuracy of any shooter. If you know archery is your game and know the weight bow you want to shoot, you will learn faster and gain confidence quicker starting with the best.

### Selecting Recreational and Tournament Equipment

For recreational and tournament shooting you must select a bow that you can hold easily. If you have never shot a bow before, a good rule of thumb is to buy a bow which you can hold at full draw for 10 seconds. A little tremor is all right, but if you start to shake, the bow is too heavy. The muscles used for archery will develop quickly. With two weeks of 30-minutes-a-day practice, you can hold the proper weight bow comfortably all day long. If you have shot before and your muscles have already developed, better buy a bow you can hold without shaking for 20 seconds.

For accurate shooting, the arrow must match your bow weight. If an arrow matches the bow properly it snakes around the bow when it is shot. It actually doesn't touch the bow except for the first inch or so of travel. The most important factor in this fitting is stiffness. This is why all Bear arrows are matched in spine (stiffness). The more expensive the arrows, the closer they are matched, until the ultimate, Bear Eastons, which are precisely uniform in stiffness, weight distribution, center of gravity, diameter and wall thickness. The weight of the bow the arrows match is written on the end label of the box. The length is also noted.

Buy an arrow long enough to let you stretch out when drawing. To determine arrow length come to full draw, (fingers in the corner of your mouth and bow arm straight) stretch out and have someone measure the distance from your fingers to the far side of the bow. You may find that as you develop and smooth out your shooting form your draw increases. Buy arrows long enough, but don't overdo it. Unnecessary length means extra weight that robs you of velocity.

### Roving is the Carefree Sport

If your heart is in the woods and fields, roving may be your meat... the glorious, carefree sport of wandering through the woods shooting at any interesting, safe target. Bagging small game, should they appear, isn't against the rules by any means. (Check hunting laws in your state.) For a start, the Bear Cub does a wonderful job in the field, but you will want a large back quiver such as the Texan to hold an assortment of field point, blunt and broadhead arrows. A Master Glove and a Hunter Armguard (to hold loose clothing tight to your arm) will complete the required tackle except for the missiles. Wooden arrows cost less, but accuracy counts here, too.

Money buys accuracy in arrows, and if your area is such that you don't lose many arrows, the durability of the A-20 makes it the most economical . . . as well as terrifically accurate. About the only thing that will break an A-20 is side-slapping a tree or other objects.

As your shooting improves and the hunter in you emerges, you will want to step up to the Grizzly<sup>®</sup>. You will want a quiver that keeps your arrows silent and ready for use as the Huntsman Quiver or the Fred Bear Bow Quiver does.

### Selecting the Hunting Equipment

Finally the opportunity comes for big game hunting: fox, deer, elk, moose, bear or what have you. Now, you will have to carefully plan the proper equipment around the type of country, the weather, and the hunting conditions.

The power packed Kodiak® is my first choice, unless I am shooting from a tree, blind, boat or other such close quarters. Then I use a Kodiak® Magnum. The convenience of this little beauty in this type of hunting makes the choice of the Magnum more than worthwhile. Durable, accurate A-20's are a must. If brush will be a problem, the Fred Bear Bow Quiver will allow you to carry your arrows through without a thought, and arrows can't be any handier for that second shot. If you anticipate much rain, the St. Charles Quiver will keep your arrows dry as well as sharp and quiet. By this time you will appreciate the positive position of the Pro Cordovan glove.

Men should not hunt big game with bows of less than 45 pounds. Few people come ready-equipped with muscles to handle a bow of this weight, but any normal person under sixty can develop a physique to handle this weight and much more.

No one will ever develop to shoot heavier bows by practicing with lighter ones. One could shoot a 40 pound bow for years and never be able to handle a fifty pound weight. Muscles are developed by overworking them and breaking them down. The human body responds by rushing reserves in larger numbers than are needed and the muscles are built up stronger.


Obtain a bow of proper hunting weight. Shoot it until you become too tired to hold it back at full draw. You may shoot only a dozen arrows and these only two at a time for several days.

On the third day, shoot again, but only two to three arrows at a time. Perhaps eighteen can be shot at this time.

I cannot over-emphasize the danger of developing bad habits when working out with a heavy bow. This can be prevented by being certain that every shot is taken at a full and extended draw and that at least a second or two is taken for aiming.

Continue exercise every other day. An average person can, in this way, develop himself to handle as much as 60 to 70 pounds, which is the most anyone needs for the largest of big game. Not everyone will want to put this much into archery hunting but any archer can easily work into a 50 pound bow, which is satisfactory for deer, black bear or other animals of this size.

Whatever your inclinations are, you'll find pleasure and satisfactions in the interesting sport of archery.

Every Bear Bow is numbered and accompanied by a registration card which must be filled out and mailed by the purchaser or his Bear Dealer within 10 days after date of purchase. Should failure occur in a bow so registered within a period of six months after date of purchase, the Bear Archery Company will make free repair, or replacement if repair is not feasible, unless the bow shows evidence of mis-use or improper handling. Claimant must be the original owner and bow serial number must be

After six months and up to one year after the purchase date and provided the bow has not been mis-used or mishandled, repair or replacement will be made for 25% of the list purchase price. From two years to three years, the charge will be 90% of the purchase price.

No adjustment will be made until the damaged bow is returned to the factory for inspection. Replacement will be made with a bow of the same model and weight, as near as possible. Dealers are not authorized to make adjustments, but they will be glad to handle the shipping and correspondence for you.


### HOW TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR BOW

Take care of your bow . . . While not in use. keep your bow unstrung. Hang it vertically or lay it across pegs supporting both limbs. Keep it in a bow case in a cool, dry spot. When used

in rain or snow, wipe dry before storing. In cold weather, flex bow several times to "warm it up." Occasionally, apply a light coat of furniture wax to protect finish.

- 3. An arrow that does not wobble in flight.

## Fred Bear's Field Notes

Travel with the master bowhunter as he stalks the Alaskan Brown Bear.

Left Kodiak at 4 A.M., Thursday, May 17.

Saw a dark object on the beach at Marmot Island. We circled through the spruce to the far end of the beach. Finally reached a point thirty yards from him. A brownie! One more move, and he would be in position for my favorite rib-lung shot. The move turned out to be a look to scan the beach. There we were, naked so to speak. Brownie ran off, with much woofing.

On Saturday, May 19, we left Seal Bay heading North. Monday, May 21, we started for the Alaskan Peninsula. We went along the west side of Afognak to Paramanof Bay. I looked out the galley window. There was a bear walking across the beach. We made a stalk, but the wind was wrong. He sneaked over the mountain through a draw.

Sunday, May 27, was the big day, anchored at Puale Bay. We rounded a point and the beach came into view. A fine bear chose this time to walk out of the alders into sight on the beach.

Before we reached shore, he waded out into the ocean. Rolled over on his back, and with head and four feet sticking out, enjoyed the refreshment of a salt water bath. While rowing across the bay, I shot some 16 mm. film of the bear. On shore, Harley (my hunting companion) was to pinch hit as photographer.

Leaving the skiff, we made our way toward a point that afforded a view of the beach and the bear. Ahead was a big rock about 4 by 4 feet. Kneeling down, we made our way to it. We kept our heads down, and waited in great anticipation for the appearance of this alder king. I thought of the three strands of my bowstring—chafed off on sharp barnacles as I had gotten out of the skiff. Would it hold for this one shot?

Finally, there he was. Twenty-five feet away and coming closer. He turned and looked us over. We were as motionless and quiet as stumps. (Stationary objects are not considered harmful to the animal kingdom.) He walked to pass us. The 65 pound Kodiak bow came back with the ease of a toy. The Razorhead® sank to the feathers, close up to the front leg. This shook him up. He roared and started highballing right down along

shore. Straight toward Harley who sized up the situation with mixed emotions.

He ground away with the camera until the bear began to more than fill the viewer. The open part of the shore . . . between the steep alder-covered high water mark and the water . . . was a scant twenty feet. Harley's position was smack in the middle. The bear's direction of travel was also right down the middle. Harley was all legs and arms flailing the air, cameras in one hand, rifle in the other, trying to scurry up the slope to clear the open shore for the bear.



The bear passed him at full speed. A short way beyond, it tried to climb into the alders, but could not make it. It rolled out of the brush and onto the shore. He was dead in less than a minute after he was hit.

With the carcass intact, he tipped the scales at 810 pounds. The skin squared nine feet. The length and width of the skull measured 27 inches. An arrow in the right spot will do the job quickly and humanely, regardless of the size of the animal. A good-sized brownie strutting toward one at twenty-five feet is a thrill well worth the time and effort. It's a great privilege to match wits with such a noble animal, that Nature so ably equips to take care of itself.
