DAY 1: November 10, 2019

Professional Program

Guest program:

Guests will explore Sentosa this afternoon, home to an exciting array of spa, resorts, lush rainforest, beaches and residences. Ride from mainland via the Singapore cable car for a bird's eye view of Singapore's city skyline, the harbor and Sentosa itself. Up next, catch panoramic views across Singapore, Sentosa and the Southern Islands from Asia's tallest free-standing observation tower. Take in an award winning outdoor multi-sensory presentation water display with laser show, fire effects and spectacular music.

DAY 4: November 13, 2019

Professional program

Today spend the day meeting with local HR professionals or government officials from the Ministries of Labor and Education. The focus of the program is on how HR professionals ensure that they have the right talent when and where they need it while maintaining high standards of professionalism in HR management, talent acquisition, and talent development.

Lunch will be provided this afternoon.

Guest program:

Your tour will begin with a visit to the iconic Marina Bay Sands SkyPark. They are home to the world's largest public cantilever housing a public observatory deck and spectacular views. Continue on to the Helix Bridge, a 280-meter pedestrian link way. Next, explore the Majestic Gardens. Gardens by the Bay spans over 100 hectares and was built at a cost of over one billion dollars in 2012. The gardens house two conservatories, Cloud Forest and Flower Dome, which are both climate- controlled indoor glasshouses.

DAY 5: November 14, 2019

Professional program

Continue your professional meetings with **local HR professionals** from local businesses such as **PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP** or enterprise application **software leader SAP**.

Guest program:

Today, your tour will begin with a leisurely bumboat ride along the Singapore River. The ride will end at Merlion Park at Esplanade Bridge where your tour continues with a drive around the Civic District past the Padang, Cricket Club, Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. Next stop will be one of the oldest and most important Hokkien temples in Singapore, Thian Hock Keng Temple. Last stop is the National Orchid Garden, within the Singapore Botanic Gardens, which boasts a colorful display of 60,000 orchid plants, with 400 species and more than 2,000 hybrids represented. Remember to look out for Vanda 'Miss Joaquim', the national flower of Singapore, also known as the Singapore orchid.
