This letter concerns your future role as Dep. Sec. Defense. Please consider adopting the strategic objectives and tactics herein to fix the acquisition process.

Objectives

Strategic objectives to transform the acquisition of weapon systems.

- 1. Hold contractors and DoD program managers accountable for outcomes.
- 2. Tear down NDIA's barrier to entry facing non-traditional defense contractors.
- 3. Eliminate regulations that increase costs and enable false reporting.
- 4. Institutionalize digital engineering.

Implementation Tactics

- 1. Revoke DFARS Earned Value Management (EVM) regulation. Compliance requirements and reviews divert a program manager's focus from the product to the process. Reward real engineering, not financial engineering.
- 2. Reduce personnel at contractors and DoD that perform non-value-added tasks.
- 3. Replace periodic, misleading, manipulated EVM reports of schedule and cost performance with realtime, automated status reports that are based on Authoritative Sources of Truth. Replace botched metrics with outcome-based metrics.
- 4. Provide goals to USD nominees, Mr. Duffey and Mr. Michael.
- 5. Establish common objectives with Sec. Def. Hegseth and Mr. Vought.

Senate Confirmation Hearing

Letters referenced below contain Advance Policy Questions (APQ) for Dr. LaPlante, Dr. Plumb, and Mr. Andrews at previous Senate confirmation hearings and commitments that were stated but not kept.

Problem

DoD does not acquire weapon systems that work and are completed on time and under cost. Federal statutes, regulations, and DoD policy provide incentives that reward deceptive practices and failure, not successful outcomes.
