

Arthur Taylor

1864 — 19522

Arthur Gilman Taylor, 87, a resident of Grant township for the past 70 years, passed away early Sunday morning of a cerebral hemorrhage in the Stevens Nursing Home, Cass City, where he had been a patient for the past four years.

Mr. Taylor was born on December 19, 1864, in Canada, and at the age of 17 moved to Grant township. He was united in marriage in 1887 to Miss Dora Lambkin, and they cleared the land for the farm where his youngest son, Albert, now lives.

Mrs. Taylor died in 1923, and in 1930 he married Miss Lydia Parker, who died last September. Two daughters, Mrs. Audrey McDonald and Mrs. Edith Pethers, and a son, Ernest, also preceded him in death.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. David Young, of Eklton; two sons, Frank, of Bay City, and Albert, of Elkton; ten grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the Canboro L. D. S. Church on Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with Elder Silas Parker officiating. Interment was in the Williamstown cemetery, Gagetown.
