Fr. Vargas and I met last week. We discussed our school, students, and the structure of masses. He asked me to communicate the following to families.

As Catholics, the Holy Eucharist is one of the most sacred gifts we can receive. Catholics who attend mass on Sundays and practice the faith are able to receive communion at weekly masses such as our Friday mass. We teach students that if we miss mass on Sunday, it is our duty to attend confession to ready ourselves to then receive the Eucharist the following week. Friday masses do not take the place of Sunday mass. He would like all students to attend Sunday mass regularly, so they are fully ready to also receive the Eucharist at weekly masses.

- 3. Please send a note to your child's teacher (grades K 4th especially) as we are beginning the year. Sometimes the younger students do not know if they are eating hot lunch or a lunch from home!
