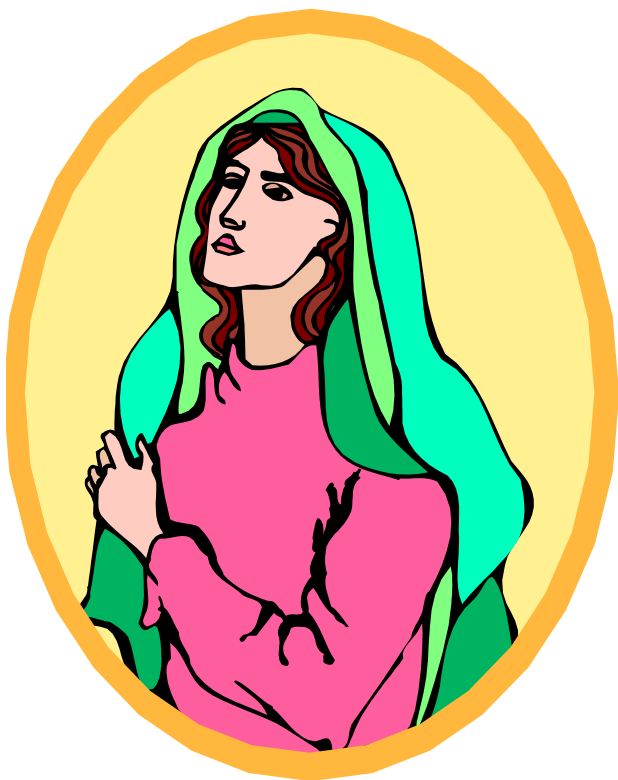


Deborah's Story

This is called a prophet.



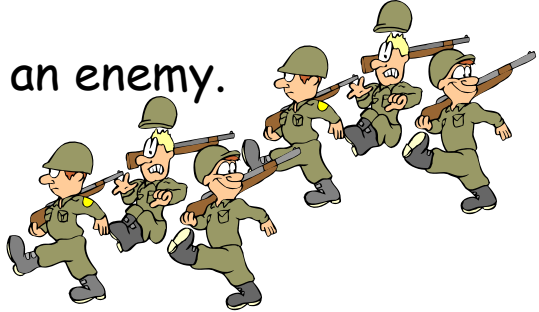
My office is under

with their problems.

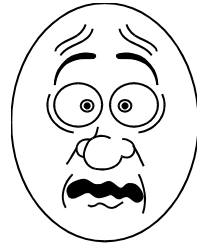


I sent a message to Barak.

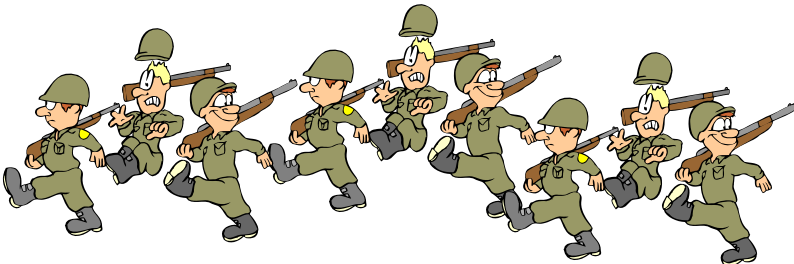
God wanted him to lead the

This tent is her home.



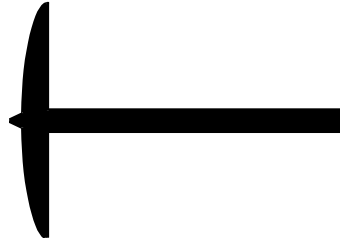
When guests come she offers

After Barak and his team beat the enemy, their leader fled to Jael's tent.

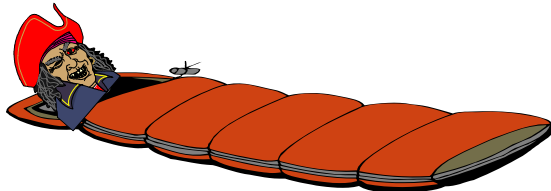
Jael offered him food and drink and he went to sleep,

I WILL MAKE MUSIC TO THE LORD!

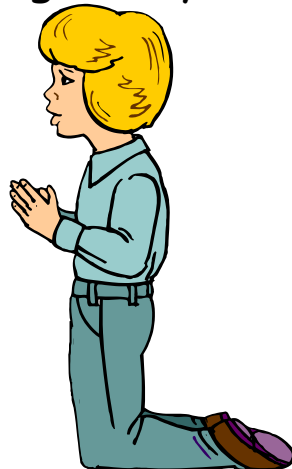
Deborah's story happened at a time when God's people did not listen to Him, and many bad people tried to hurt her friends.
