

Weekly Progress

Parents will receive weekly emails from our online learning platform, Edgenuity. These emails will let you know how much progress your child has made week to week.

As a reminder, we ask our students to meet a **25% minimum progress goal each week**. This will ensure that they earn at least 1 credit each month. Our goal is to graduate students on time.

Weekly progress monitoring is a way to ensure this goal is met for 100% of our students!
