Supervisor May called the board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the meeting minutes from August 11, 2022, with correction on page 2. On a motion from Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Flint, to approve the minutes. Ayes [5] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried

Supervisor May explained that Ms. Kern will possibly attend next month meeting.

Supervisor May requested a resolution for the Court Grant. On a motion by Mr. Flint, seconded by Mr. Herman, The Town Board of the Town of Orangeville authorizes the Town of Orangeville Town Court to apply for a JCAP grant in the

Zoning Officer Report: Planning Board will have two land separations this month, Malicki and Ulm. T-Mobile would like to place an antenna on Orangeville Center Road, they are sending the plans in the mail. We will need a resolution from the Town Board to add a price to this permit process. This will be placed on the American Tower. There are two solar arrays that will be placed, one on Almeter road (94.8 megawatts) and one on Krotz road (2.5 mega Watts).

The Town Board will have Supervisor May discuss this with Mr. DiMatteo regarding pricing for community solar. Will bench mark with other towns, fee, application and difference in size and megawatts.

Town Clerks Report:

The Towns total revenue for the month of August was \$1053.00, \$170.00 for Zoning, \$198.00 for dog licenses, and \$685.00 for DEC. We had 4 new licenses and 21 renewal licenses. To the general fund, \$272.78, Dogs were \$65.00, \$37.78 for DEC and \$170.00 for Zoning. We disbursed \$110.00 to Wyoming County, \$23.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs and \$647.22 to the DEC. Supervisor May has contacted Reisdorf, to set up a meeting regarding the audit.

A motion to go into Executive Session for an employee issue, this motion was made Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Ahl at 7:37pm. Ayes [5] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried

A motion to return from Executive Session at 7:57pm was made by Mr. Flint, seconded by Mr. Herman. Ayes [5] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2022 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #9 vouchers #141 through 152 totaling \$28,615.27. A motion was made by Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Flint to approve the payment of the Highway bills. Ayes [5] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2022 General Fund Bills: - Abstract #9 Vouchers #172 through 190 totaling \$41,981.63. A motion was made by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Herman to approve the payment of the General Fund bills. Ayes [5] May Boxler Flint Herman Ahl. Noes [0] Carried
