I. BACKGROUND

- 1. On August 18, 2016, this Court entered its *Order Appointing Receiver* which appointed Peter S. Davis as Receiver of DenSco Investment Corporation ("Receivership Order").
- 2. The Receiver, during his investigation into the assets of DenSco, determined that DenSco is a secured creditor, in first position, over the assets of Furniture King, LLC ("FK"), an Arizona limited liability company formed on August 26, 2011, Furniture & Electronic King, LLC ("FEK"), an Arizona limited liability company formed on December 4, 2015, and Scott's Fine Furniture, LLC ("SFF"), an Arizona limited liability company formed on March 23, 2016 (collectively hereinafter "Furniture King"). Specifically, DenSco has a primary secured interest in all of Furniture King's accounts, assets, equipment [and the proceeds thereof] pursuant to a Forbearance Agreement dated April 16, 2014, between DenSco and a DenSco borrower, Yomtov Scott Menaged. DenSco's status as a secured creditor of Furniture King was pursuant to the terms of a perfected security agreement and a UCC-1 Financing Statement [Recorded at 2014-001-5063-0]. Given that FEK and SFF were the continuation of FK, the Receiver was a secured creditor of all assets of Furniture King.
- 3. The Receiver, given his first position secured interest in all of Furniture King's assets and in conjunction with the Bankruptcy Trustee for Yomtov Scott Menaged ("Trustee"), [the sole owner of FK, SFF and FEK] entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Trustee in the Bankruptcy Court and filed a Stipulation in the Receivership Court seeking, among other things, to place FK, SFF and FEK into Receivership for the purpose of

liquidating the Furniture King assets and approving a 90-10 split of the net sale proceeds from the liquidation of the Furniture King assets.

- 4. On September 19, 2016, this Court entered its Order Placing Furniture King, LLC, Scott's Fine Furniture, LLC and Furniture and Electronic King, LLC in Receivership ("Furniture King Order").
- 5. After the entry of the Furniture King Order, the Receiver surveyed the known locations of Furniture King and as set forth in detail in the Receiver's Petition No. 12; the Receiver organized, inventoried and secured the assets of Furniture King, which consisted of 5,766 pieces of assembled and unassembled furniture ("Furniture King Assets").

II. REPORT ON LIQUIDATION OF ASSETS

- 6. On January 31, 2017, the Court entered its Order re: Petition No. 12, which approved the procedures by which the Receiver would liquidate the Furniture King Assets. Pursuant to Order re: Petition No. 12, the Receiver retained Surplus Asset Management, Inc. ("SAM") to assist with the sale of the Furniture King Assets. SAM sold the Furniture King Assets via an online storefront, directly from the warehouse, and at various public auctions.
- 7. Attached hereto is the Final Report of Peter S. Davis, as Receiver of Furniture King. [See Exhibit A] As set forth in the report, the Furniture King Assets were liquidated for \$273,663.42. After accounting for costs and expenses totaling \$212,026.03, the net cash recovery from the liquidation of the Furniture King Assets was \$61,637.39.

- 8. Pursuant to the Furniture King Order and the terms of the Settlement Agreement between the Receiver and Yomtov Scott Menaged's Bankruptcy Trustee, ten percent (10%) of the net recoveries from the sale of the Furniture King Assets is to be paid to the Trustee. Accordingly, upon the entry of an order approving this Petition, the Receiver intends to pay a total of \$6,163.73 to the Trustee.
- 9. After payment to the Trustee, the remaining amount of \$55,473.66 shall be paid to DenSco, as DenSco is the sole secured creditor of Furniture King pursuant to the terms of a perfected security agreement and a UCC-1 Financing Statement [Recorded at 2014-001-5063-0].

III. KNOWN CREDITORS OF FURNITURE KING

- 10. During his investigation of the liabilities of Furniture King, the Receiver determined that Furniture King may have a number of other creditors. Specifically, the Receiver is aware of the following creditors of Furniture King:

- 11. The Receiver has not paid these creditors, as the Receivership Order does not contemplate these creditors being paid, as DenSco is the first position secured creditor to the assets of Furniture King.

V. DISCHARGING THE RECEIVER FROM LIABILITY

- 12. The Receiver seeks an Order discharging the Receiver and his employees, agents, attorneys and assistants from any and all further duties, liabilities and responsibilities to Furniture King and its creditors, claimants, beneficiaries, shareholders, owners, members and all others after the Receiver complies with the procedures authorized by this Court's Order terminating the Furniture King Receivership.
- 13. The Receiver also seeks an Order indemnifying the Receiver and his employees, agents, attorneys, and assistants from any and all further liability to the parties' creditors, claimants, beneficiaries, members or owners to the fullest extent of the law. Receiver also seeks an Order enjoining all persons who receive notice of this Order or of the Receivership proceeding from commencing and prosecuting any action against the Receiver or his agents, employees, attorneys or assistants in connection with, or arising out of, the

Receivership services to this Court in this Receivership without leave from this Court. The Receiver requests that this Court enter an Order retaining jurisdiction for the purpose of enforcing the above injunctive relief.

IV. TERMINATION OF RECEIVERSHIP OVER FURNITURE KING

14. With the assets of Furniture King being liquidated, the Receiver requests that upon the entry of an Order, the Receivership of Furniture King, LLC, Scott's Fine Furniture. LLC and Furniture and Electronic King, LLC be deemed terminated without further proceedings or orders of this Court.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, the Receiver respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order:

- 1. Approving the Receiver's Petition No. 53 and the Receiver's Final Report attached hereto as Exhibit "A";
- 2. Directing the Receiver to pay \$6,163.73 to Jill H. Ford in her capacity as Bankruptcy Trustee for Yomtov Scott Menaged;
- 3. Directing the Receiver to pay \$55,473.66 to DenSco Investment Corporation; and
- 4. Discharging the Receiver and his employees, agents, attorneys and assistants from any and all further duties, liabilities and responsibilities to Furniture King and its creditors, claimants, beneficiaries, shareholders, owners, members and all others; and

terminating the Receivership over Furniture King, LLC, Scott's Fine Furniture, LLC and

1. Background and Appointment of the Receiver

DenSco Investment Corporation ("DenSco") is an Arizona corporation formed by Denny Chittick in April 2001.¹ DenSco was engaged primarily in funding the purchase of real estate secured by deeds of trust using money raised from investors.²

On August 18, 2016, Peter Davis was appointed Receiver ("Receiver") for the assets of DenSco by the Honorable Lori Horn Bustamante of the Maricopa County Superior Court. The Receiver issued his Preliminary Report to the Court on September 19, 2016. The Receiver also issued Status Reports to the Court on December 23, 2016 and December 22, 2017. The Receiver hereby incorporates all of the background information, opinions, conclusions, and other information contained in the previously issued reports in this report.

As discussed in the Receiver's prior reports, approximately 92% of DenSco's loans receivable (as of the date of the DenSco receivership) were due from a single borrower, Yomtov Scott Menaged ("Menaged"), his family members, or his related companies, Arizona Home Foreclosures, LLC ("AHF") and Easy Investments, LLC ("Easy").

On April 16, 2014, DenSco entered into a Forbearance Agreement with Menaged, AHF, Easy, and another Menaged entity, Furniture King, LLC ("FK"), in which FK agreed to guarantee \$35,639,881 in loans due from AHF and Easy. Pursuant to the Forbearance Agreement, AHF and Easy's obligations to DenSco were secured by a lien against all of FK's assets.³ In addition, DenSco filed a UCC Financing Statement with the Arizona Secretary of State on May 8, 2014, documenting DenSco's interest in FK's inventory and other assets. ⁴ Menaged filed personal Chapter 7 bankruptcy on April 20, 2016, and Jill H. Ford was appointed as the Chapter 7 Trustee ("Trustee").

Furniture & Electronic King, LLC ("FEK") is a continuation or successor of FK, and Scott's Fine Furniture, LLC ("SFF") is a continuation or successor of FEK. Given that FEK and SFF are the successors of FK, the Receiver contends he is a secured creditor of all assets of all three entities. Collectively, FK, FEK, and SFF are hereinafter referred to as Furniture King.

The Receiver determined that DenSco has a secured interest in all of Furniture King's accounts, assets, and equipment, and that DenSco is in a priority position to receive the overwhelming majority of funds from the liquidation of the assets of Furniture King. Accordingly, the Receiver and the Trustee entered into a Settlement Agreement whereby the Trustee agreed to stipulate to an order placing Furniture King in receivership in exchange for the Receiver's agreement to distribute 10% of DenSco's portion of the net recoveries from Furniture King's assets to the Trustee for the benefit of Menaged's creditors. On September 14, 2016, both the Settlement Agreement and the Stipulation were filed with the respective Courts. On September 19, 2016, the Maricopa County Superior Court entered an Order placing Furniture King into receivership.

2. Furniture King Receivership Activities

Shortly after being appointed Receiver of Furniture King, the Receiver gained access to two (2) retail stores, one located on West Bell Road in Glendale, Arizona, and another located on West Van Buren Road in Goodyear, Arizona. The assets contained in these stores were subsequently consolidated into a single warehouse located on 27th Avenue in Phoenix, Arizona. In addition, the Receiver took possession and control of the existing warehouse located on 45th Avenue in Phoenix, Arizona.

The Receiver's staff prepared detailed inventories of the assets contained in the warehouses and identified approximately 5,766 pieces of consumer furniture and related décor with a wholesale value of approximately \$1,000,000 and an estimated liquidation value between \$275,000 and \$360,000.

Additional actions taken by the Receiver with regard to the Furniture King assets are set forth in detail in the Receiver's *Petition for Approval of Procedures for the Sale of Furniture King Assets*, which was filed with the Court on December 21, 2016. The Court signed the corresponding Order ("Liquidation Order") approving the Receiver's proposed liquidation procedures on January 31, 2017. Pursuant to the Liquidation Order, the Receiver retained Surplus Asset Management, Inc. ("SAM") to assist with the sale of the Furniture King assets. SAM sold the Furniture King assets via an online storefront, directly from the warehouse, and at various auctions. SAM completed the final sale on September 25, 2017.

3. Furniture King Receivership Accounting

During the course of the Furniture King receivership, the Receiver collected a total of \$273,663.42 and disbursed a total of \$212,026.03, resulting in net proceeds of \$61,637.39, as summarized in **Table 1** below and discussed in **Section 3.1** and **Section 3.2** respectively. A detailed list of the corresponding transactions is attached hereto at **Exhibit 1**.

3.1. Collections

The Receiver has collected a total of \$273,663.42 on behalf of the Furniture King Receivership Estate as of the date of this report, as discussed in detail below.

SAM collected proceeds totaling \$189,686.13 from onsite and internet sales plus \$82,891.09 in auction proceeds, for a total of \$272,577.22.

In addition, the Receiver sent a demand letter instructing Chase Bank to turn over to the Receiver all funds held in Furniture King's pre-receivership bank account as of the date it was placed in receivership, or September 27, 2016. Accordingly, the Receiver received a cashier's check from Chase Bank in the amount of \$951.43 on December 7, 2016.

Finally, the Receiver received (1) a check payable to Furniture King in the amount of \$105.43 for a utility refund issued by the City of Glendale; and (2) a check payable to Scott's Fine Furniture in the amount of \$29.34 for an insurance refund issued by American Modern Select Insurance Company.

3.2. Disbursements

The Receiver has disbursed a total of \$212,026.03 on behalf of the Furniture King Receivership Estate as of the date of this report, as discussed in detail below.

SAM received commissions of 15% of the total sales, or \$40,886.58. SAM also received reimbursement of its out-of-pocket costs totaling \$13,331.00 for advertising and marketing, furniture moving and staging, and a forklift repair.

The Receiver has disbursed a total of \$149,255.05 to marshal and protect the assets of Furniture King, et al., including (1) \$59,562.43 in rent to Predio Management, LLC for the 27th Avenue warehouse; (2) \$58,739.12 in rent to SBMC Van Buren Industrial, LLC for the 45th Avenue warehouse; (3) \$24,613.50 to Atlantic Relocation Systems to relocate the furniture assets from the Glendale and Goodyear stores to the 27th Avenue warehouse; and (4) \$6,340.00 to Seneca Insurance Company, Inc. for insurance on the furniture assets held at all locations.

In addition, the Receiver disbursed \$8,438.40 to Paychex for unpaid payroll liabilities, including (1) \$6,000.00 due for payroll paid to Furniture King employees for which Paychex was not reimbursed; (2) \$2,060.90 in past due worker's comp coverage for a prior period; and (3) \$377.50 for the preparation of the 2016 W-2 forms. As Receiver of Furniture King, the Receiver was obligated to prepare and distribute the W-2 forms to the former Furniture King employees. Because the Receiver did not have sufficient records to prepare the forms in-house, and because the cost to gather such information would likely have exceeded the amounts due to Paychex, the Receiver paid the past due balance and retained Paychex to prepare the required tax forms.

Finally, the Receiver paid fees totaling \$115.00 to the Arizona Corporation Commission for reporting changes to the address and statutory agent of the Furniture King entities and to reinstate FK after it was administratively dissolved.
