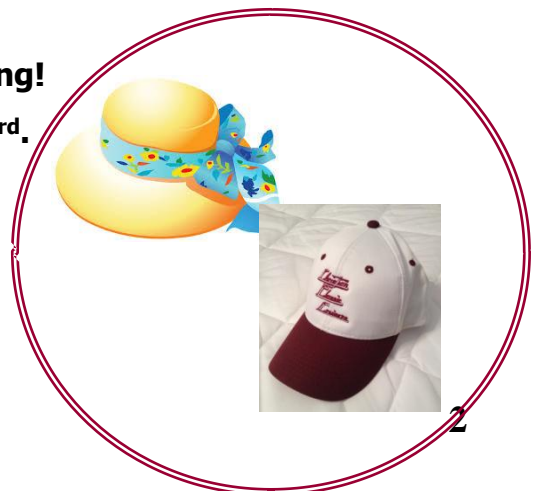
IMPORTANT NOTICE

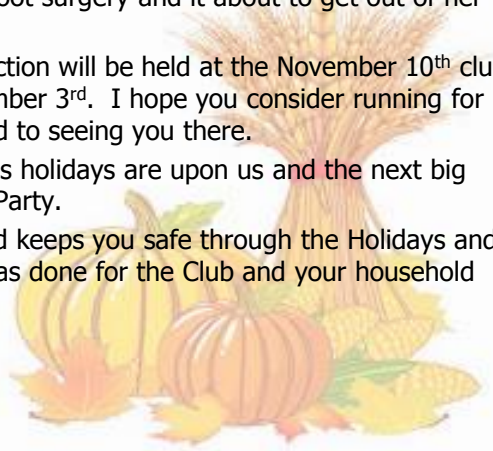

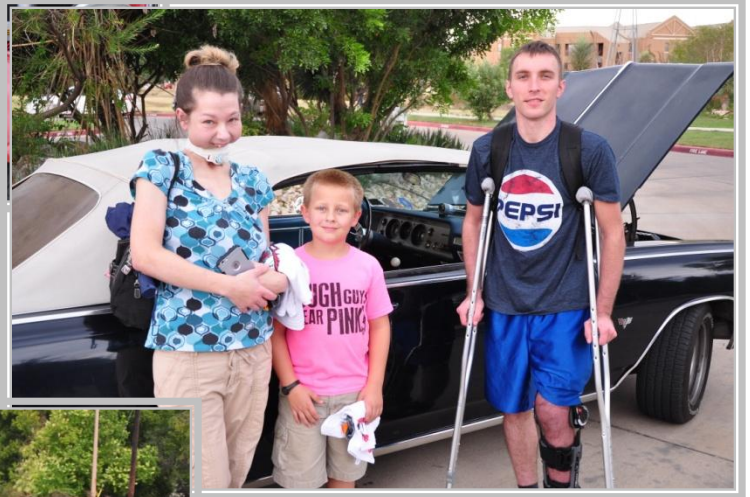

Car Trivia (Special Edition)

This rare 1935 Stout Scarab is back on display at the Detroit Historical Museum in Michigan. It is considered to be the precursor of the minivan – 50 years ahead of its time! Created by William Bushnell Stout (any relation Bobby?). No Scarabs were ever sold on the market. Only 9 were made and only 5 are known to remain in existence. Each were handmade and no two were alike.

These photos are of the model made for the 1935 Detroit Auto Show but the company folded before the show was held. Instead, it went to one of its investors, Philip K. Wrigley, of chewing gum and Chicago baseball fame. He kept it at his summer home and in the late 1950's, it was donated to the Detroit Historical Society.

Look closely at the photos and note the woven wicker ceiling, movable seats, single spoke steering wheel, Art Deco-styled dash gauges, and the beetle like flaps that open to access the rear engine.

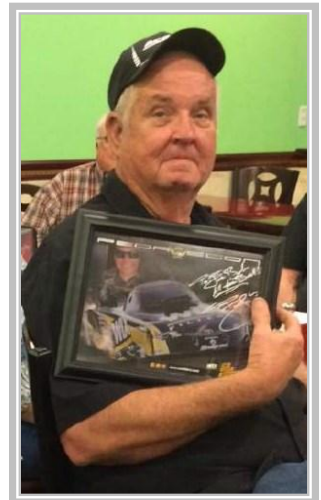
