Cook'em Girl!
Caldeirada (Fish Soup)**

Take out a wide bottom pot and place it on medium heat. Add a splash of olive oil. Finely chop 4 garlic cloves and one jalapeno and add it to the pot. Sauté until it starts to sizzle. Add a bay leaf if you like. Chunky cut 1 large or 2 small onions and 3 green peppers, add to the pot. Add about 3 peeled potatoes chunks. When that starts to stick to the bottom of the pan add a pinch of saffron. Add a cup of white wine and a can of chopped tomatoes (or 4 fresh). Put enough water in the pot to cover and about 4 extra inches. Next add your seafood. Fresh chunks of seabass or any other white meat fish, some shrimp or a seafood medley (Trade Joe's makes a nice one). Cook until fish becomes white, don't overcook. Sprinkle with some fresh chopped Italian parsley and squeeze a lemon over it. This makes a great "pot meal" ... invite some friends and have everyone bring a seafood item. Make the base and add the fish as they come.
