

# OTC Ride at John Day (the "un-rally"), Sep 12-14 By Tom Nielsen

It was a great week to ride for many reasons. The weather was fine, cool in the mornings, but not too hot in the afternoon. John Day has a population of about 1,700, so with kids at school, there was very little traffic. Club members were on their own for accommodations, so none of the chores related to a typical rally needed doing, leaving everyone free to enjoy the rides. The ride routes had been planned out some years ago. The campsites were roomy with nice amenities. We had daily viewings of wildlife. John Day has a nice selection of restaurants and the food is good.

We had eight members attend, so the group rides were very manageable. Rides included paved roads through farmland, mountain vistas, sweeping curves through canyons, ranging from 78 to 200 miles. One of the highlights for me was the ride through Seneca, where the general store offers home-made lemonade and sandwiches, and they have ethanol-free gas. Sitting there for lunch, the locals come through for their lunch and almost always say hi and stop to chat.

There were no mechanical breakdowns. The most serious mishap was my long-stem mirror broke at the elbow joint from vibration. The club plans to repeat this event in 2024.





# Minutes of the Oregon Trail Chapter of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America August 14, 2023

President James McQuiston called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM by conference call.

**Officers in Attendance:** James McQuiston Pres., Tim Burns VP, Tom Nielsen Secretary, John Davey Treasurer.

**Other Attendees:** Martin Doerfler and Jennifer Nielsen.

**Treasurer's Report and Membership:** Club remains in the black. Made money at rally.

**Minutes:** Reading of minutes was waived. See newsletter.

#### Correspondence:

- ✓ James sent out email to rally attendees asking for their feedback. Received about eight responses, everyone was very positive.
- James had calls with Keith Kizer regarding accident during rally. Confirmed we had completed waivers. Then James talked with John Markley, AMCA board member, who follows insurance. Asked them if there are rules when non-members might join us for a ride and how handle that. James reported that they said "If we just go out for a ride, just go out for a ride. If we start advertising, and get people who are not members, in that case, we want waiver

[completed by non-members?] to protect the club."

#### Old Business:

Regarding memorial bricks for Rosie Singhose, Chuck Hodson, Jim and Laverne Lancaster, Jen made a motion to get a brick, seconded by John, motion passed unanimously. Tom N will work with Tom Ruttan to work out details. Tom N talked to James Radway (Rosie's grandson) who was appreciative of the memorial brick. And that we would leave a space for Jim Singhose next to Rosie.

#### New Business:

- Tom N asked if we want to do a waiver that covers the entire year. James said when we renew each year, should do an annual waiver. Tim suggested we have members sign an annual waiver when they send in dues each year. All agreed that would be good way to proceed. Jen asked if we should have waivers available if nonmembers show up. James thought that would be easy to do. Jen said consider doing electronically on a smart-phone. Tom N asked if Markley said it was ok for non-members to come along [on a ride]. James said if a non-member shows up for a ride, like at John Day, we just ask them to sign a waiver to protect the club.
- Martin asked if we want to check if they have a decent helmet. We don't need to be helmet nazis, but the poor guy [Williams who was in accident] got his face busted up, and that didn't need to happen if he'd worn a real helmet. Jen shared she got to see him at hospital when she dropped off his sunglasses and lost her mojo for riding motorcycles after seeing him in the hospital. James said we need to emphasize safety; he mentioned one rider at our rally wore flip flops. Tim said that individual has been on many many road runs and other chapters arn't saying anything. James said we can't force them to be safe, but at least if we suggest they do, we better protect ourselves.
- John asked if we are signing a waiver for national, why do we need to do it for the chapter. No one remembers whether we do a national waiver with AMCA. James will check with Keith. Jen suggested maybe waivers should be done by national, that when we sign up for annual dues with AMCA, that we sign a waiver then and AMCA is in charge of that. James has tried to contact Keith but he's out, but he will follow up with Keith re waiver.



- James asked about thank you notes to sponsors. Tom N reported that Jen and he sent thank you notes to folks we contacted: Cycle Gears in Portland and Beaverton, Russ Brown, Paradise HD, MotoCorsa, and See See Coffee. It's not a "must-have" to do thank you notes, but it's appreciated. We got positive feed back from David Young at Russ Brown and from folks at Paradise for our notes. Need to get thank you notes to Bill's Cycle, Cycle Gear in Salem, and our recovery drivers Chet Turner, Nils Olson, and Martin Doerfler; Kris Thompson donated use of recover vehicle and trailer; and donations from Robin and Jen (Tom will send note to Robin, James will send to Jen). Tom will text list to James, and James will send them notes. James has gift from 6-volt and bag from Viking we can use at some future event.
- Upcoming Club Events
  - August. Martin, Tim, and Nielsen's going to Tenino swap meet.
  - September. Have club ride in John Day week of September 11<sup>th</sup>. James asked if we had route maps. Tom N said he has digital files of maps and will send out to all club members a week before event, and if they are coming, they can use. Tom N and John also have paper copies they will bring.
  - October event. Nothing scheduled yet.
     Martin said Bill Quaccia talked about another garage crawl. We've done in past. Martin will follow up with Bill on a date.
  - November. Jen mentioned in past we have a museum help day and club provides a lunch. We should do well before Thanksgiving so doesn't interfere with holiday. We set date as November 11<sup>th</sup> at 11 AM. Tom N will confirm with Tom Ruttan.
  - December. Christmas party at Tim's. Tom N suggested 2<sup>nd</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup>; Tim will confirm. [later confirmed December 2<sup>nd</sup>].
- ✓ Election. James gave update. Ballots received by Tom Ruttan show new officers: James McQuiston, President; Tim, VP; Martin, Secretary; John, Treasurer. New terms start October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Tom N gave update on transition from GoDaddy to Club Express for our chapter website.
  GoDaddy costs our chapter \$357.64 annually and renews in April 2024. Club Express does website for AMCA national, and we can host our chapter website for free, but we must rebuild the website. When James and Tom discussed transition in

- spring, goal was to do transition to Club Express this year, but keep GoDaddy site open through April, with a link to the new Club Express site. It is a lot of work to build new website. Danny Podkowa volunteered to help. Tom said new website will look a lot like current one, but if someone wants something different or had any input, we can consider in setting up new website.
- ✓ James discussed new Instagram account. Danny Podkowa set it up and seemed excited to maintain it. Jen said Danny's been consistently posting on it. Jen and Tim said he's doing a nice job and seems to be having fun doing it.
- ✓ James has talked twice to Robert Williams (who had accident at rally), he seems to be recovering and has a positive attitude.
- ✓ Jen made a motion to donate \$150 to food bank in Rainbow it is run by Robin at Harbicks. Harbicks were so supportive of our rally and the donation will show our appreciation. Seconded by John. Motion passed. Jennifer will prepare a thank you note, send the note to John, who will write a check and mail the note and check to Robin at Harbicks.
- Tom N discussed transition of secretary duties. Tom will get thumb drive to Martin with files on agendas, rally info, etc. Martin wants to do in person. Agreed to set a date to meet.
- Newsletter has been in progress for a while. Expect to come out in a week.
