Our prayer group meets faithfully on Mondays at 9:30 AM to lift our joys and concerns in corporate prayer. This was Lyn Kane's ministry as promised to Doris Hinkhouse years ago which we are faithfully continuing in love.

Pastor Chris provides compassionate care for all who seek it. She is also starting a Friends of the Wild worship opportunity and a women's ecumenical group (see detailed information at the end of this letter for details on attending these events). We strive to make a difference in our wider community as well as in the lives of our beloved members and attenders by hosting community events such as the Everything Sale, the Hymn Sing and Pie and Ice Cream Social (fundraising for the Domestic Violence Intervention Program) as part of Hoover Hometown Days, and the free Community Brunch as part of the West Branch Christmas Past events. We support our college-aged Friends by sending Valentine care packages. Singers from our meeting joined others in the community in providing music for our citywide MLK celebration in January at the Town Hall.

We donate to many Friends organizations, as well as special collections for CommUnity in Iowa City (which maintains a food bank and offers crisis intervention for individuals and families in need), the West Branch/Paws Food Pantry, our Love Fund, and the Domestic Violence Intervention Program which covers our eight county area. We were pleased to be able to offer the Peace Scholarship and the James Thompson Scholarship to Nina Torkelson, a member of the congregation.

We were grateful to be invited by West Branch Conservative Friends to observe and participate in an Arapaho ceremony at the West Branch Cemetery in honor of two American Indian youth who died while at the West Branch Industrial School many years ago while under the care of Friends. We are glad to support Mary Denmead of our meeting who will be joining Friends Bringing Hope in February as they work with widows in Kenya who are rebuilding their houses and lives.

We greatly grieve the passing this year of Diane Painter, Stan Hinkhouse, and Lyn Kane. Our hearts go out to their families and friends who mourn their loss. We miss Diane's artistry and her passion for life, Stan's quiet (yet colorful!) presence and faithfulness, and Lyn's card ministry and her deep care for others. We are reminded with their passing to be grateful for each day given to us.

As members of the Society of Friends in our sometimes contentious world we continue to work to be living examples of the historic Quaker testimonies of simplicity, peace, integrity, community, equality and stewardship (SPICES). We do enjoy hearing from Friends all over the world and hope that you will join us for worship in person or via Zoom. As we say in closing at the end of worship every Sunday, "God is love, all the time, and all the time, God is love."
