Public Works

 him to install an additional sewer line and connect to the town's system. Mr. Fricke asked that Mr.

- Mr. Thompson told council that they are working on getting letters out in regard to cross-connection assemblies. He will talk more with Paul Sifford, regarding the next step, on May 8th.
